THE FAUNA AND FLORA PROTECTION ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 469)

Order under Sub-section (1) of Section 2

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Sub section (1) of Section 2 of the Fauna and Flora Protection Ordinance (Chapter 469), I, Maithripala Sirisena, Minister of Agriculture, Irrigation and Mahaweli Development and Environment, do by this Order :-

- (1) declare the area of State land described in the Schedule hereto to be a National Reserve for the purposes of the aforesaid Ordinance ;
- (2) declare that the aforesaid area of land declared to be a National Reserve and described in the Schedule hereto, shall be a National Park for the purposes of the aforesaid Ordinance ; and
- (3) declare that the area of land declared by this Order to be a National Park shall be called and know as the “Kumana National Park”.

SCHEDULE

LIMITS OF THE AREA OF LAND DECLARED TO BE A NATIONAL RESERVE AND A NATIONAL PARK

All that area of State in extent 35664.74 Hectares, situated within the Divisional Secretary's Division of Lahugala in the Administrative District of Ampara, and bounded as follows :-

- East :* From Thillanwela situated along the seafront at Okanda in a South westerly direction along the sea shore to the point where the Kumbukkan Oya meets the sea at the Kumana estuary ;
- South :* From the last mentioned point in a North westerly direction along the Kumbukkan Oya to the Divulanagoda Trigonometrical station along the straight line drawn from there onwards to the point where it meets the Kumbukkan Oya ;
- West :* From the last mentioned point along a straight line drawn in a northerly direction across the Divulanagoda Trigonometrical station, till such straight line meets Alakola Aru ; and
- North :* From the above last mentioned point in a North easterly direction along the straight line drawn towards the Budhdubawa Trigonometrical station, and then eastwards along the straight line drawn upto the point where it meets the Panama Kumana road ; from then onwards in a South easterly direction along the said road the from there in a straight line drawn westwards of the starting point Thillanwela, upto the point where it meets the said road and from there eastwards till the straight line meets the original starting point.

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
