#### THE WAGES BOARDS ORDINANCE

##### Wages Board for the Hosiery Manufacturing Trade

In accordance with the provisions of Section 28 of the Wages Boards Ordinance (Chapter 136), the Wages Board for the Hosiery Manufacturing Trade hereby notifies that the Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by Section 30 of the aforesaid Ordinance, proposes to vary in the manner set out in the schedule hereto, such decisions of the Board as are specified in that Schedule.

Objections to the aforesaid proposal will be received by the Chairman of the Board until 12.00 noon on 28.07.2004.

Every such objection must be made in writing and must contain a statement of the grounds upon which such objection is taken.

#### SCHEDULE

The decisions made by the Wages Board for the Hosiery Manufacturing Trade and set out in the Schedule to the notification published in *Gazette* No. 14725 of 9th December 1966 as varied from time to time and last varied by the notification in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1173/04 of 26th February 2001, shall be further varied by the substitution for Part II of that schedule of the following new part :

#### *Part II*

##### Minimum Rates of Wages for a Month

##### Class of Workers

##### Grade I

Chief Workers or Leaders, Section Supervisors, Laying Machine Operators.

## Grade II

Kier Boiler Operators, Steam-Boiler Operators, Washing Machine Operators, Dyeing Machine Operators, Stantexing Machine Operators, Hydor Extraction Machine Operators, Cialendering Machine Operators, Drying Machine Operators, Machine Mechanics (General Purposes), dyes (Males), Knitting Machine Mechanics, Screen Printers, Screen Printing Operatives (Females), Screen Prining Assistants, Sewing Machine Mechanics.

## Grade III

Fabric Laying Operators (Females), Cutting Machine Operators, Electric Cutter Operators, Cutters (Hand), Sewing Machine Operators, Boiling Fabric Labourers, Bleaching Operatives (Males) Knitting Machine Operators, Mending Operatives (Females), Trimming Operatives (Females), Ironing Operatives (Females), Ironing Operatives (Males), Electric Iron Operators, Checking Operatives (Females), Sorting Operative (Females), Packers, Packing and Stamping Operative (Females) Shoe Lace, Cord Making and Brainding Machine Operators, Cellopane Bags and Cardboard Box Makers, Winding Machine Operators.

## Grade IV

Learners or Apprentices (The period of apprenticeship in relation to any learner of apprentice referred to above shall be deemed to consist of 156 working days).
