FAUNA AND FLORA PROTECTION ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 469)

Order under Section 2

ORDER made by the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources under Sub-section (1) of Section 2 of the Fauna and Flora Protection Ordinance (Chapter 469).

It is hereby declared, that the area of State land specified in the Schedule hereto, shall be a National Reserve for the purposes of the Fauna and Flora Protection Ordinance (Chapter 469).

The above area of land declared to be a National Reserve the limits of which are specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a National Park and shall be called and known as the “ Horagolla National Park ”.

SCHEDULE

All that extent of land known as the Horagolla Forest situated at the Village of Nambadaluwa in the Udugaha Pattuwa of Siyane Korale East Divisional Revenue Division of the Gampaha District and containing in extent of 33 Acres and bounded as follows :—

On the North by land called Weviliyadda claimed by N. G. Girigoris and others, land called Daviwakootuwa claimed by I. D. Sisilia and others ;

On the East by land called Galewatta claimed by A. P. Jacolis Appuhamy and Rampala and others, Coconut land and forest called Horagollawatta claimed by Mrs. Sirima R. D. Bandaranaike and others ;

On the South by forest called Horagollawatta claimed by Mrs. Sirima R. D. Bandaranaike and others ;

On the West by forest called Horagollawatta pelapolwatta claimed by Mrs. Sirima R. D. Bandaranaike and others and Pinnagolla watta claimed by Rockman Dias Bandaranaike.
