### Land Acquisition Notices

#### THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT (CHAPTER 460)

##### Declaration under Section 5

I, Anura Kumara Dissanayake, Minister of Agriculture, Livestock, Lands and Irrigation do hereby declare under Sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the Land Acquisition Act, that the land described below is required for a public purpose and will be acquired under the provisions of that Act.

Three allotments of land containing in extent 1.513 hectares out of the entirety of the land depicted in the advance tracing No. GAM/BIYA/03/21 prepared by the Surveyor General which land is situated in the village of Bollegala in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Biyagama, Gampaha District and bounded as follows:
