TRUSTS ORDINANCE

Order under Section 114

WHEREAS the Trustees of the “Senthil Kumaran Memorial Trust” namely—

1. Visvanathamoorthy Govindasamy,
2. M/S. Secretaries and Financial Services (Private) Limited.

have applied to the Minister of Justice and Judicial Reforms for their incorporation under Section 114 of the Trusts Ordinance (Chapter 87),

Now therefore, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the aforesaid Section, I, Welathanthrige Don John Seneviratne, Minister of Justice and Judicial Reforms do by this Order, authorize the incorporation of the said Trustees and direct and declare—

- (a) that the said Trustees and their Successors for the time being duly appointed under the rules of “Senthil Kumaran Memorial Trust” and the Instrument of Trust bearing No. 90, dated 25th day of November, 2004, attested by Seanikan Christina Perera, Notary Public of Colombo, shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal under the name and style of the “Senthil Kumaran Memorial Trust” ;
- (b) that by the said name and style the said Trustees may purchase, hold or otherwise acquire, sell, donate, mortgage, pledge or otherwise, dispose of movable or immovable property of any description on behalf of the said Trust ; and
- (c) that the Trustees shall by the said name and style be able and competent in law to sue and to be sued, to answer and to be answered to defend and to be defended, in any court in Sri Lanka or elsewhere in all causes and actions in respect of the said Trust.

This Order may be revoked, or from time to time be varied or amended in such manner as appear to me to be necessary.
