THE ARMY ACT, (CHAPTER 357)

REGULATION made by the President under Section 155 of the Army Act, (Chapter 357) read with Section 29 of the aforesaid Act, and with paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

Regulation

The Army Pensions and Gratuities Code, 1981 made under Section 155 of the Army Act, (Chapter 357) read with Section 29 of the aforesaid Act, and with paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 562/11 of June 15, 1989, is hereby amended in regulation 3 of that regulation by the addition of the following new sub-paragraph immediately after sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) thereof –

“(b) Notwithstanding anything in this regulation the Secretary to the Ministry in charge of the subject of Defence, may in consultation with the Commander of the Army, retain the services of an officer, other than a Short Service Field Commissioned Officer, in any rank beyond the period specified for that rank in paragraph (1)(b) or beyond the age specified in paragraph (1) (c), if in the opinion of the President, it is essential in the interest of the Army to do so.”.

THE NAVY ACT, (CHAPTER 358)

REGULATION made by the President under Section 161 of the Navy Act, (Chapter 358) read with paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

Regulation

The Navy Pensions and Gratuities Code, 1981 made under Section 161 of the Navy Act, (Chapter 358) read with paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 654/10 of March 20, 1991, is hereby amended in paragraph (2) of regulation 3 of that regulation by the insertion immediately before sub-paragraph (b) of that paragraph of the following sub-paragraph -

“(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1), the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister in charge of the subject of Defence, may in consultation with the Commander of the Navy, retain the services of an officer in any rank beyond the period stipulated for that rank in that paragraph or beyond the age specified in respect of that rank in that paragraph, if in the opinion of the President it is essential in the interest of the Navy to do so.”.

The Air Force Pensions and Gratuities Code, 1981 made under Section 155 of the Air Force Act, (Chapter 359) read with Section 29 of the aforesaid Act, and with paragraph (2) of Article 44 of the Constitution and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 645/8 of January 16, 1991, is hereby amended in regulation 3 of that regulation by the addition of the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (2) thereof -

“(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (2), the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister in charge of the subject of Defence, may in consultation with the Commander of the Air Force, retain the services of an officer in any rank beyond the period stipulated for that rank in that paragraph or beyond the age specified in respect of that rank in that paragraph, if in the opinion of the President it is essential in the interest of the Air Force to do so.”.
