Glassware Manufacturing Trade

IT is hereby notified under Section 29(3) read with Section 33(3) of the Wages Boards Ordinance (Chapter 136), that the determination relating to the minimum rate of wages for time work in respect of workers in the Glassware Manufacturing Trade specified in the Schedule hereto made by the Commissioner of Labour under Section 33(2) of the aforesaid ordinance, in pursuance of the authority conferred on him by an order made by the Minister of Labour under Section 33(1)(a) of the Ordinance and published in *Gazette* No. 58 of October 12, 1979, has been approved by the Minister of Labour Relations and Foreign Employment.

The determination shall come into force on the 01st day of August, 2005.

SCHEDULE

The determination made by the Commissioner of Labour relating to the minimum rate's of Wages for time work in respect of workers of the Glassware Manufacturing Trade and set out in the Schedule to the notification Published in *Gazette* No. 94/6 of 26th June 1980, of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as varied from the time to time *Gazette* No. 667/16 of 21st June, *Gazette* No. 999/20 of 31st October 1997, *Gazette* No. 1102/13 of 18th October, 1999 and last varied by the notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 1245/1 of 15th July, 2002, shall be further varied by the substitution for that schedule of the following new Schedule.
