THE REGISTRATION OF PERSONS ACT, No. 32 OF 1968

REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Public Security, Law and Order under section 52 of the Registration of Persons Act, No. 32 of 1968.

Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as the Registration of Persons Regulations 2005.

2. The Registration of Persons Regulations 1971, made under section 52 of the Registration of Persons Act, No. 32 of 1968 and published in *Gazette* No. 14,991 of December 30, 1971 is hereby amended as follows : –

- (1) in paragraph (3) of regulation 3 of that regulation by the substitution for the words “age of eighteen years” wherever such words appear in that paragraph of the words “age of sixteen years”;
- (2) by the repeal of regulation 6 of that regulation and the substitution therefor of the following : –

“6. (1) For the purposes of section 15 of the Act, the prescribed officers shall be –

- (a) a District Secretary of any administrative district; or
- (b) an Additional District Secretary; or
- (c) a Divisional Secretary; or
- (d) a Grama Niladhari; or
- (e) the Commissioner – General of Labour; or
- (f) the Commissioner of Labour; or
- (g) a Deputy Commissioner of Labour; or
- (h) an Assistant Commissioner of Labour; or
- (i) a Labour Officer; or
- (j) a member of the Sri Lanka Army, or the Sri Lanka Navy, or the Sri Lanka Air Force, who is designated as an authorised member of the forces under section 7A (1) of the Immigrants and Emigrants Act (Chapter 351); or
- (k) an Authorised Officer appointed under section 4 (1) of the Immigrants and Emigrants Act (Chapter 351); or
- (l) a Police officer of any rank; or
- (m) a Peace Officer; and

(n) an Investigating Inspector of the Post and Telecommunication Department.

- (2) Where after the coming into operation of these regulations, the title of any post specified in paragraph (1) of this regulation is changed, then, the officer holding an equivalent designation shall be deemed to be a prescribed officer”;

- (3) in regulation 12 of that regulation:-

- (a) by the renumbering of regulation 12 as paragraph (1) thereof;
- (b) in the renumbered paragraph (1), by the substitution for the words “retouching of the photograph or the print;” appearing in sub-paragraph (f) thereof, of the words “retouching of or removing of any marks or scars from the photograph or the print;” and
- (c) by the addition immediately after the renumbered paragraph (1) thereof, of the following new paragraph:-

“(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-paragraph (e) of paragraph (1) of this regulation, from and after the coming into operation of these regulations, every photograph submitted along with an application for an identity card, shall be in colour :

Provided that, the Commissioner may, in exigent circumstances, after the coming into operation of this regulation, require that a photograph in black and white be furnished”;

- (4) Forms “B”, “D”, “E” and “F” of the Schedule to that regulation are hereby repealed and the following Forms substituted therefor : –
