LAND REFORM ACT, No. 1 OF 1972

Order under Section 27A(1)

BY virtue of powers vested me by Section 22A(1) of the Land Reform Act, No. 1 of 1972 as amended by Acts, No. 39 of 1975, 14 of 1981, 39 of 1981, 14 of 1986 and 18 of 1986. I, Anura Priyadarshana Yapa, Minister of Plantation Industries under the Provisions of the said Act devest under this order the Agriculture Land indicated in Schedule. I here to vested in Land Reform Commission, in the National Housing Development Authority established under National Housing Development Authority Act, No. 17 of 1979 as amended by Act, No. 5 of 1982 for a sum of Rupees Sixty One Thousand and Four Hundred Ninety One (Rs. 61,491) paid to the Land Reform Commission by the said Authority for a purpose indicated in Schedule 2 hereto, with effect from 18.10.2005.

The land called Kuruduwatta depicted as Lot 01 of Preliminary Plan Maha 3436 of 19.07.1988 drawn by surveyor General, bounded North by Lot No. 72 and No. 71 of P. P. Maha 2296 and V.C. Road from Malwatta Village to Main Road, East by V.C. Road from Malwatta Village to Main Road and Main Road from Dolosbage to Gampola, South by Main Road from Dolosbage to Gampola and V.C. Road from Main Road to Malwatta Village and West by V.C. Road from Main Road to Malwatta Village and Lot No. 72 of P.P. Maha 2296, situated in Kuruduwatta Village of Ganga Ihala Korale Minor Division in Ganga Ihala Korale Divisional Secretary's Division of Kandy District in Central Province containing in extent Two Decimal Three Eight Three Hectares (2.383 Hectares).
