THE WAGES BOARDS ORDINANCE

Janitorial Service Trade

IT is hereby notified under Section 29(3) read with Section 33(3) of the Wages Boards Ordinance (Chapter 136), that the determination relating to the minimum rate of wages for time work in respect of workers in the Janitorial Service Trade, specified in the Schedule hereto made by the Commissioner of Labour, under Section 33(2) of the aforesaid Ordinance. In pursuance of the authority conferred on him by an Order made by the Minister of Labour Relations and Foreign Employment under Section 33(1)(a) of the ordinance and published in *Gazette* No. 744 of 04th December, 1992, has been approved by the Minister of Labour.

The determination shall come into force on 01st October, 2005.

SCHEDULE

The determinations made by the Commissioner of Labour relating to the minimum rates of wages for time work in respect of workers in the Janitorial Service Trade and set out in the Schedule to the Notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 774/5 of 7th July 1993 as varied from time to time and last varied by the Notification in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1283/23 of 11th April, 2003, shall be further varied by the substitution of the following new Schedule.

The minimum rate of wages for time work applicable to the workers in the Janitorial Service Trade specified in Column I, shall be the rate set out in the corresponding entry in Column II.

(a) <i>Operational Personnel</i> - Cleaners, Conservancy Labourers, Janitors or Employees performing functions howsoever designated in cleaning offices and establishments	168.80
(b) <i>Supervisory Personnel</i> - Employees in-charge of Operational Personnel, Officers in-charge, Shift Supervisors or Supervisors	189.50
