LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE LAW No. 16 OF 1974

THE regulations made by me as the Minister of Provincial Councils and Local Government under Section 23 of the Local Government Service Law No. 16 of 1974 as amended by Act, No. 10 of 1985 are published herewith.

Regulations

1. These regulations may be cited as "Local Government Service Pension (amendment) Regulations, 2005".
2. The pension of every pensioner who had served and subsequently retired from Local Government Service in terms of Local Government Service Law No. 16 of 1974 as amended by Local Government Service (amendment) Act, No. 10 of 1985 and is receiving a pension under Local Government Service Pension Regulations 1975, shall be revised subject to the regulations specified hereinafter.
3. (i) With effect from 01st January, 2004 every pensioner shall be paid a pension calculated in accordance with the schedule to these regulations assuming that he was in the salary step in which he could have been on 31st December, 1996 taking into consideration the salary revisions done from time to time to the salary scale by the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Administration, attached to his post and the annual salary step in which he was placed at the time he retired.
(ii) The amount of pension which can be paid to him should be determined in the manner specified in the schedule to these regulations based on the annual salary computed in the manner specified in Para 3(i) above.
(iii) The pension computed in the manner specified in Para 3(ii) above shall be paid to the pensioner with effect from 01st January, 2004.

4. In determining the annual salary entitled to a pensioner as at 31st December, 1996 in terms of regulations 3, the promotions, salary increments and stagnation benefits of that pensioner from the date he retired to 31st December, 1996 shall not be taken into account.

5. Where the revised pension of a pensioner calculated in accordance with the provisions of these regulations is less than the pension he is already drawing, he shall be paid the pension he was already drawing.

6. With effect from 01st December, 2004, the unreduced pension without the allowances of every pensioner shall be increased by 15 percent subject to a minimum of Rupees Seven Hundred and Fifty and a maximum of Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred.

7. In these regulations, "the pensioner" means a pensioner who receives any pension under Local Government Service Pension Regulations 1975 but does not include a person who had been a member of Local Government Service and subsequently absorbed in to any Provincial Public Service.

1. When calculating pensions according to this table 01% should be deducted from the above percentage for every six months or a portion thereof below 25 years of service.
2. No pay leave upto a period of one year should not be considered.
3. When the period of no pay leave exceeds one year, 0.2% should be deducted from the above percentage for every exceeding months or a portion thereof, when calculating the pension.
4. Unreduced pension calculating percentage shown in Column A, and reduced pension calculating percentage shown in Column B.
