TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 269)

Order Under Section 6(2) (b) and Section 21 (2) (b)

BY virtue of the powers vested in me under Section 6(2) (b) and Section 21(2)(b) of the Town and Country Planning Ordinance (chapter 269), I, Dinesh Chandra Rupasinghe Gunawardena, Minister of Urban Development and Sacred Area Development, do by this order:-

- (a) declare that the area of land specified in the Schedule hereto shall be an urban development area for the purpose of the aforesaid ordinance and shall be called the “Ampara Buddhangala Aranya Senasana Sacred Area”; and
- (b) direct that an outline scheme shall be prepared for the whole of the area declared to be the Ampara Buddhangala Aranya Senasana Sacred Area.

SCHEDULE

The area of land containing the Ampara Buddhangala Aranya Senasana Sacred Area

The area of land containing in an extent of 62.3298 and 6.1771 Hectares shown respectively by No. 01 and 03 in the Tracing No. AM/UHN/2006/480 and situated in Buddhangala within the Divisional Secretary's Division of Uhana in the Administration District of Ampara in the Eastern Province and bounded as follows:-

Tracing No. 01

North: Considering the live boundary rock shown in the South Western direction in No. 01 of the above tracing as the starting point, go straight for 804.9 meters towards the Eastern direction along the Northern boundary of above Lot No. 01 upto the live boundary rock which is met.

SCHEDULE (contd...)

East: Starting from the last point on the Northern boundary, go straight for 608.9 meters towards the Southern direction along the Eastern boundary of Lot No. 01, upto the reservation of the road running from Ampara to Ruhunugama depicted as Lot No. 02 of above tracing.

South: Starting from the last point on the above Eastern boundary, go up to the Southern boundary of Lot No. 01 in above tracing, which is met when going for 474.8 meters along the said reservation towards the South-West and from there upto the reservation of the road running from Ampara to Ruhunugama shown by Lot No. 04 of above tracing, which is met when going for 295.2 meters to the West along the Southern boundary and from there upto the Southern boundary of Lot No. 01 which is met again when going for 105.5 meters towards the West along the said road reservation and from there upto the boundary rock which is met when going for 11.3 meters to the West along the above boundary.

West: Starting from the last point on the above Southern boundary up to starting point of the above Northern boundary which is met again when going straight for 803.3 meters towards the Northern direction.

Tracing No. 03

North: Starting from the turning point of the road reservation found at a distance of 10.3 meters away towards the South-East, from the culvert shown in lot No. 02 of above tracing which shows a portion of the reservation of the road running from Ampara to Ruhunugama, up to the point which meets the Lot No. 02 in the Preliminary Plan No. M125, which is met at a distance of 142.3 meters along the above road reservation and the Lot No. 03 of this tracing.

East: Starting from the last point on the Northern boundary up to the boundary rock, which is met when going straight for 173.5 meters towards the South along the Eastern boundary of Lot No. 03.

South: Starting from the last point on the Eastern boundary up to the boundary rock of the reservation of the road running from Ampara to Ruhunugama which is met when going for 350.8 meters to the West straight along the Southern boundary of the Lot No. 03.

West: Starting from the last point of above Southern boundary upto the starting point of the above Northern boundary which is met when going for 274.2 meters along the reservation of the road running from Ampara to Ruhunugama.
