THE INDUSTRIAL DISPUTES ACT, CHAPTER 131

THE award transmitted to me by the Arbitrator to whom the Industrial Dispute which has arisen between Mr. Sahendra de Silva, No. 118/1, Devsiripura Road, Talawakele, of the one part and Ceylon Hotels Corporation, No. 411, Galle Road, Colombo 04 of the other part was referred by order dated 11.09.2003 made under Section 4(1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 (as amended) and published in the *Gazette* No. 1306/7 of 15.09.2003 for settlement by arbitration is hereby published in terms of Section 18 (1) of the said Act.

The Honourable Minister of Employment and Labour by virtue of the powers vested in him by Section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon (1956 Revised Edition) as amended by Act, Nos. 14 of 1957, 62 of 1957, 4 of 1962 and 39 of 1968, read with Industrial Disputes (Special Provisions) Act, No. 37 of 1968 appointed me as the Arbitrator by his order dated 11th September, 2003, and referred the dispute between the aforesaid parties to me for settlement by Arbitration.

The matter in dispute between the aforesaid parties is :

“Whether the termination of the employment of Mr. B. P. Sahendra De Silva by Ceylon Hotels Corporation with effect from 21.09.1995 is justified and if not to what relief he is entitled.”

2. Mr. Wilbert Perera appeared for the applicant, B. P. Sahendra de Silva while Mr. D. K. Dhanapala, Attorney-at-Law assisted by Mr. K. G. Jinsena, Attorney-at-Law appeared for the respondent, Ceylon Hotels Corporation.

There were 16 sittings and applicant tendered productions marked A1 to A15 while respondent tendered productions marked R1 to R6.

3. On 22nd August, 1995, the applicant in this case was driving the corporation Vehicle No. 17-5380, and had an accident, Kandana Police initiated prosecution against the applicant on 03 charges, viz :

1. Driving the Vehicle No. 17-5380 carefreely damaging the Vehicle No. 21-2826 due to carelessness,

speeding, are amongst other things ; neglected to drive cautiously,

2. Failure to avoid an accident, by reducing the speed, failing to blow the horn etc.,
3. Being under the influence of liquor whilst driving.

After the trial, acting D. J./Magistrate Wattala found him guilty of the (1st) charge, but acquitted on (2nd) and (3rd) charges. Applicant aggrieved on the said Order, appealed to the High Court, Negombo and was exonerated.

4. While, Court action was pending, respondent interdicted the applicant ; charge sheeted and held a domestic inquiry on 4 charges. The Four charges were-

1. That on the 22nd August, 1995 that he had driven a corporation vehicle and caused an accident with a three wheeler, and
2. Brought about disrepute to the corporation, in that, the driver of the three wheeler (21-2826) had claimed damages in a sum of Rs. 50,000, and
3. That he had failed to report the accident to the management, and
4. That by these actions has proved that he is not fit and proper person who can work in the corporation.

The applicant requested in writing that the domestic inquiry be postponed until conclusion of the court action, but the management continued with the inquiry and found him guilty on 1st and 4th charges.

The inquiry officer has come to this conclusion specifically on the ground that the applicant was under the influence of liquor whilst driving.

5. My findings are as follows-

- (1) Respondent corporation had relied heavily on the disciplinary procedure laid down in Establishments Code, (Vol. II) which provisions apply to public officers only. Establishments Code, defines the "Public Officer" to mean *any person who holds any paid office under the Republic, other than a Judicial officer but does not include-*
 - (a) The President ; (b) The Speaker ; (c) A Minister ; (d) A Member of the Judicial Services Commission ; (e) A Member of the Public Services

Commission ; (f) Deputy Minister ; (g) A Member of the Parliament ; (h) The Secretary of General of Parliament ; (i) A Member of the President Staff ; (j) A Member of the Staff of the Secretary General of Parliament ; (k) **Employees of Statutory Boards and Corporations and Institutions** Vested in the Government, Establishments Code, (Vol. II) does not apply to the applicant ;

- (2) In the arbitration proceeding respondent failed to field the vital witness, Atapattu to give evidence. His evidence at the domestic inquiry is also not marked. Pages 1 to 7 of the domestic inquiry proceedings have not been submitted as a production, or placed before courts for evaluation. As such it cannot be said that the domestic inquiry was a full and final and a fair inquiry ;
- (3) On receipt of the domestic inquiry officers Report, management should have examined the strengths and the weakness of the inquiry officer's report, before a final decision was taken ;
- (4) The police officer who testified at the domestic inquiry had at no stage stated, that a breathalyzer test was carried out. Domestic inquiry was closed on 10th July 1996, OIC, Kandana Police by his letter dated 16th July, 1996, writes that the applicant was under influence of liquor ;
- (5) Medical Officer (Medico-Legal) Dr. (Miss) E. A. S. D. Edirisinghe reports to court that the applicant was-
 - (b) No smelling of liquor ; and
 - (c) Not under influence of liquor.

On the basis of this report magistrate stated in her order-

- (6) Although commission of the offences dates back to 22nd August, 1996, the Magistrates court case concluded on 6th March, 1998, while the appeal in the High Court concluded on 31st July, 2002. Hasty decision by the respondent, in rejecting the request to postpone the Domestic Inquiry until the conclusion of the court case is unacceptable ;
- (7) In conclusion I find that the decision of the management in relation to the charges against the applicant will not prevail-

- as there is want of *bona fides*
- it is a case of victimization or unfair labour practice, in violation of the principles of natural justice,
- there is a basic error on facts, and
- there has been a perverse finding on the material.

THE AWARD

The Honourable Minister of Labour by virtue of the powers vested in him by Section 4 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 of the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon (1956 Revised Edition) as amended by Act, Nos. 14 of 1957, 63 of 1957, 4 of 1962 and 39 of 1968, (read with Industrial Disputes (Special Provisions) Act, No. 37 of 1968, appointed me to be the Arbitrator and referred the aforesaid dispute to me for settlement by Arbitration by his letter dated 05.08.2000.

The matters in dispute between the aforesaid parties are :

(1) Whether the termination of the service of seven hundred and seventeen (717) employees whose names are referred to in the attached schedule "A" by Fine Lanka Luggage (Pvt.) Limited is justified and to what relief each of them is entitled, and

(2) Whether the dismissal from services of thirty five (35) employees whose name are referred to in the attached schedule 'B' is justified and to what relief each of them is entitled.

02. Mr. Sinnathamby, Attorney-at-Law with Miss. Ganeshamurthi appeared for the applicant Union, Mr. Anton Marcus, General Secretary of the Free Trade Zones Workers Union (Substituted as Free Trade Zones and General Services Employees Union) represented the Union. Mr. Shirley Fernando, P.C. with Mr. Noel Thalapawala appeared for the Respondent Company.

03. As the dispute involved the termination of the services of 717 employees whose names are referred in Schedule A and dismissal of 35 employees from service name in Schedule B, I tried to settle this matter amicably but as both parties failed to accept my suggestion, I had no alternative but to

6. In the circumstances, I order the restatement of the applicant workman, within one month from the date of publication of this award in the Government *Gazette*, subject to the following conditions-

- (a) back wages to be computed based on the last drawn salary, (*i.e.*— from the date of dismissal up to the date of reinstatement) ;
- (b) there shall be no break in service ;
- (c) Increments to be earned, after the reinstatement in service ;
- (d) No bonus or leave pay for the period of non employment.

This is just and a fair award.

Limited, Export Processing Zone, Katunayake, of the other part was referred by order dated 05.08.2000 made under Section 4(1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, Chapter 131 (as amended) and published in the *Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka Extraordinary* No. 1,144/22 of 11.08.2000 for settlement by arbitration is hereby published in terms of Section 18 (1) of the said Act.

04. Mr. Shirley Fernando, P.C. leading evidence first, called Anuradha Upali Weerasekara who was a former Personnel Manager of the Company, but he expired before re-examination. Thereafter Susil Hendry Wijesinghe, Personnel Manager started giving evidence on 14.06.2003 and stated in his evidence that over 250 workers in schedule 'A' signed letters stating that they do not wish to have their names in schedule A in the reference and some of them signed their letters in his presence - *vide* : page 10 in proceedings on 02.10.2003 but before concluding evidence in chief the witness absented himself but the learned counsel for the Respondent did not give an explanation for his absence-*vide* : proceedings on page 1 of 17.12.2002 (page 367). This situation led to the postponement of the inquiry causing delay in concluding this matter which caused frustration among the employees. Thereafter the Respondent summoned and Miss. A. Chithrakumari Alwis, a clerk in the Respondent Company who started giving evidence on 13.03.2003. Her main task was to identify the signatures of employees who did not want or proceed with their arbitration (*vide* : R1 to R93 and R1 to R276 who referred to as X (1) and X (2) in the written submission) Mr. Sinnathamby, Attorney-at-Law who appeared for the applicant Union stated that he accepted the position that there documents were signed by the workers in the presence of the witness-Chitrakumari Alwis. (*vide* : page 1 of proceedings dated 28.11.2003). Therefore I see no merit in the position taken up by the applicant union in para. 4 (21) at page 8 of the written submissions that these documents are not acceptable. If each and every employee was to be summoned to give evidence to testify their signatures it would have taken our more than an year to conclude this inquiry which was already delayed.

05. Applicant union did not summoned any employee to substantiate its position.

06. As regards the 35 employees in schedule B the employer led some evidence that they were dismissed after two disciplinary inquiries -*vide* : reports marked R493 and R494.

These 35 employees have not shown sufficient interest and did not press their case to be present at the domestic inquiries but stubbornly walked out compelling the inquiry officer to hold the inquiries ex-exparte. I am of the view that there employees where names appears in the schedule B have no claim for any relief in there proceedings.

07. On 18.03.2005, Mr. S. Sinnathamby, Attorney-at-Law who appeared for the applicant union from the very inception

was not present in court and Mr. Jayasinghe appeared for the union thereafter, until its conclusion.

08. Mr. Shirley Fernando, P.C. for the Respondent Company led evidence of S. M. D. S. S. Pradeep, partner of P.E. Mathew to prove the documents R490/R491 and R492 the audited statements of account of the Respondent Company for the years ending 31.03.1999, 31.03.2000 and 31.03.2001. These statements of Accounts show that the Company had made reasonable profits for the 3 years.

09. Having taken into consideration that the applicant had not let any evidence on its behalf, I hold that the following employees whose names appear below are not entitled to got any relief in this matter. The figures hereunder are lased on the documents and evidence led by the Respondent Company :

(i) The names of persons who signed the Document in the presence of Miss. Kumari de Alwis (<i>Vide</i> XI and X2)	256
(ii) The names of persons who signed the Documents in the presence of Mrs. S. R. Fernando (<i>vide</i> X-4)	42
(iii) The names of persons who signed the Documents in the presence of Mrs. S. R. Fernando	08
(iv) Employees on probation (<i>Vide</i> X-7)	14
(v) Employees where name appear twice in schedule (<i>vide</i> X-B)	09
Total	<u>329</u>

10. When this member is deducted from the 717 employees in schedule A, the figure arrived is 388, and I consider that these 388 employees, where names appear in a new schedule "C" prepared by me are entitled to get some relief in these proceedings.

11. The last witness who gave evidence for the Respondent Company was Mr. P. G. R. B. Godamune, Assistant Commissioner of Labour Negombo, He produced memorandum of settlement mark R 496. According to his witness 126 employees mentioned in R496 were paid compensation.

12. Mr. Jayasinghe for the applicant Union did not elicit sufficient information from Mr. Godamune regarding the 126 employees who were paid compensation by a memorandum

were among these who withdrew from the arbitration proceedings.

13. The applicant union did not lead evidence to convince me about the plight of the employees who were out of service for above 5 year. Applicant Union should have at last summoned the Commissioner of Labour (Industrial Relations) regarding the discussions held by him with the Respondent and the Applicant union before the matter was referred to arbitration.

14. The evidence led by the Respondent Company and the documents and the written submissions tendered by both parties, reveal the following :

- (i) The employer and the applicant union were in conflict with regard to trade union matters, from 1999 ;
- (ii) There had been demonstrations against the unreasonable attitude of the employer *vis-à-vis* applicant union ;
- (iii) Commissioner of Labour had moved in to bring about a settlement to both the parties, without success ;
- (iv) at one stage the company offered employment to 427 employers in schedule A on a suggestion made at the commissioner of Labour almost immediately after the strike ;
- (v) The employer suspended the operations after the strike and I do not consider this to be a reasonable stop taken by the employer considering the plight of a large number of employees thrown out of employment.

15. Paragraph 8 the written submission of the Respondent states that there is evidence to show that the factory has been closed and 126 workers have been paid some compensation according to the scheme set out in that Memorandum. Mr. Godamune, Assist. Commissioner of Labour, Negombo, has confirmed this.

16. Taking everything into consideration I feel that at least portion of the 427 employees whom the Respondent Company offered to take back before the Commissioner of Labour should be given some relief.

17. The arbitration proceedings have taken over 5 years for completion and at least 350 workers were waiting in expectation to get some relief. The workers have complained to almost everybody including politicians for redress.

18. Mr. Godamune, Assist. Commissioner of Labour, Negombo was aware of the fact that arbitration proceedings were pending at the time of the closure of the factory and

payment of some compensation to 126 employees. The Respondent or its successors would have set apart sufficient funds to meet the claims of these employees pending the determination in the arbitration proceedings.

I therefore order the Respondent Company - Fine Lanka Luggage (Pvt.) Limited or its successor or liquidator to pay the salaries and allowances to 388 employees whose names appears in the schedule "C" from the date of termination of their services to the date of this award 25th March, 2006. The Respondent or its successor should make a correct calculation based on the records and information in its custody. The Schedule "C" excludes employees who were paid compensations by the Respondent Company at the closure of the company.

I further order the Respondent Company, its successor or liquidator to pay the salaries and allowances to the employees in the Schedule "C" within two months of the publication of this award in the *Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka*.

I consider this award just and reasonable.
