PROVINCIAL COUNCIL (PAYMENT OF SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) (AMENDMENT) STATUTE No. 01 of 2006

A Statute of further amend the Provincial Council (Payment of Salaries and Allowances) Statute No. 3 of 1989 by the Provincial Council of the North Western Province.

Be it passed by the Provincial Council of the North Western Province of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

Short Title

1. This statute may be cited as the Provincial (Payment of Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Statute No. 01 of 2006 of the Provincial Council of the North Western Province.

Amendment of
Section 2 (ඉ) and
2 (ඊ) of the
Principal Statute

2. (i) Section 2 (ඉ) of the Principal Statute is hereby amended by the substitution for the words “Rupees Seven Thousand Five Hundred” of the words “Rupees Ten Thousand”.
- (ii) Section 2 (ඊ) of the Principal Statute is hereby amended by substitution for the word “Rupees Six Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty” of the word “Rupees Seven Thousand Five Hundred”.

Sinhala text to
Prevail in case
of inconsistency

3. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil text of the statute the Sinhala text shall prevail.
