Rule

The Rule made under Section 16 of the Post Office Ordinance (Chapter 190) and published in *Gazette* No. 14707 of 5th August, 1966 as last amended by rule published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1198/25 of 22nd August, 2001 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka is hereby further amended in the Schedule thereto, by the insertion immediately after Item 970 of the following new items :
