Head Ice-cream/fruit Juice, Jam makers (by adding natural and artificial essences), Kanganies, Head syrup makers, operators of water-purifiers, Can makers, Carpenters, fillers (Automatic), Checkers.

Grade II

Assistant Ice-cream/fruit Juice, Jam makers (by adding natural and artificial essences), other workes engaged in the Manufacture of materials related to this trade, Repairers of cans, Carbondioxide gas controlmen, Assistant syrup makers, syrupers, Crowners, clean Bottle examiners, Carbonator operators, production counters, Filers (hand), Labelers (automatic), Bottle washer-off leaders, any other workers engaged in automatic machines in the production of aerated waters, Ice-harvesters.

Grade III

Ice-cream/fruit Juice/Jam can-fillers, Ice-cream/fruit Juice/Jam packers, Ice-packers, bottle unpackers, Ice-loaders, Syrup-room labourers, Bottle washer loaders, Bottle sorters or cleaners Case fillers, Bottle-packers, Cleners or sweepers, Bottle cleaners (hand), Case-carriers or attackers, Stores labourers, Labelers (hand) and vehicle loaders.
