THE INDUSTRIAL DISPUTES ACT (CHAPTER 131)

REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Labour Relations and Manpower by virtue of the powers vested in him under Section 39 of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950 (Chapter 131), and approved by Parliament.

Regulation

The Industrial Disputes Regulations, 1958 published in *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 11688 of 02nd March, 1959 as amended from time to time are hereby further amended in the Second Schedule thereto by the Substitution for Paragraph 2 of that Schedule of the following paragraph : -

“02. Subject as hereafter provided every arbitrator or a member of an Industrial Court, if he is not an officer of the Government of Sri Lanka, shall be entitled, for attendance at sittings to a fee calculated at the rate of -

- (1) (a) Rupees 600 for each sitting if the duration of such sitting does not exceed one hour ;
(b) Rupees 800 for each sitting if the duration of such sitting exceeds one hour and does not exceeds three hours ;
(c) Rupees 1,000 for each sitting if the duration of such sitting exceeds three hours.

Provided however, that the maximum amount which an arbitrator or a member of an Industrial Court shall be entitled to receive for attendance at sittings in respect of each Industrial Dispute shall be Rupees 12,000.”

- (2) Such arbitrator or member of an Industrial Court shall be entitled to an additional payment of Rupees 3,000 for each Industrial Dispute if the award in respect of such Industrial Dispute is handed over within six weeks of the conclusion of the hearing.”.
