Provincial Councils Notifications

NORTHERN PROVINCE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL NOTIFICATION

BY virtue of the powers vested in me under section 184(1)(F) of the Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987, read with section 2(2) of the Provincial Council (consequential Provisions) Act, No. 12 of 1989, I, Mohan Wijewickrama the Acting Governor, Northern Province do hereby makes rules relating to the payment of allowances to Chairman, Vice Chairman and Members of the Pradeshiya Sabha with effect from 01.06.2008.

Rules

1. These rules may be cited as rules relating to the payment of allowances to the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Members of the Pradehiya Sabha.
2. Allowances may be paid to the elected Chairman, Vice Chairman and Members of the Pradeshiya Sabha at the following rates per mensum :

Chairman	-	Rs. 10,000.00
Vice Chairman	-	Rs. 6,500.00
Member	-	Rs. 5,000.00

Entertainment allowances, too, is included in the above.

3. (1) due to any one of the following reasons the Chairman, Vice Chairman or Member of the Pradeshiya Sabha shall not have the right for the aforesaid allowances.
 - (i) Non attending to council meeting and committee meeting held in the month considered for the payment of allowances, or
 - (ii) Being kept under detention or imprisoned due to any criminal allegation, or
 - (iii) Expect for medical reasons being on leave on the approval of the council, or
 - (iv) Suspension of functioning of the Pradeshiya Sabha, or of functions of a Chairman, Vice Chairman of Member under the provisions of section 185(3), (a) of the Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987.

However, on an occasion when the period under detention or being imprisoned or on leave or under suspension of service can be counted as a part of a month, payments can be made in proportionate to the rest of the month.

- (2) Whatever, the reasons given in sub paragraph (1) of paragraph 1 of the rule 3, on an occasion when the Chairman, Vice Chairman or a Member is attending a duty on formal approval, is allowances should not be suspended due to being absent from council meeting or committee meeting.
