THE STAMP DUTY ACT, No. 43 OF 1982

Order under Section 67

BY virtue of powers vested in me by Section 67(1) of the Stamp Duty Act, No. 43 of 1982, I, Ranjith Siyambalapitiya, *Acting Minister of Finance and Planning*, do by this Order amend the rule made under Section 6 of the Stamp Ordinance (Chapter 247) and published in the *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 1470/7 of 05th August, 1966 (as last amended by *Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 1205/19 of 11th October, 2001) and deemed to be an order made under Section 67(1) of the Stamp Duty Act, No. 43 of 1982, by virtue of Sub-section 2 of that Section by the addition, after item No. 968 of that order of the following items :-
