**MINUTE ON PENSION**

**Notice under Section 51 of the Minute on Pension issued on 05th February, 1934  
and the amended Minute on Pension dated 05th May, 1972**

**NOTICE**

The Minute on Pension as amended from time to time is further amended by inserting the following proviso after Section 2ab(i) of the Minute on Pension. The said interim Section is

**2ab(1)(i)**

Further provided that officers of the Reserve Police Service presently retired or deceased, having fulfilled the qualifications in terms of Sectionn 2ab(i) and completed 15 years of active service shall be deemed that the date of first appointment be 01.01.1974 or a subsequent date.

The officers of the Reserve Police Service who have retired or deceased having completed 15 years of active service from the date of first appointment shall be entitled to a civil pension or widows' and orphans' pension as deemed.

Such officers should be treated as confirmed in the post and their civil pension or widows' and orphans' pension should be paid with effect from 23.05.2007 without payment of arrears for the period prior to this date.

Those officers who have not completed 15 years of active service as per the above conditions, but having completed 10 years of service at the time of retirement shall be entitled to a gratuity equivalent to one month salary for each completed year of active service.
