Appointment of Divisional Secretaries as Representatives of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka

NOTICE is hereby given, that in terms of Section 3 (5) of Schedule I of the Sri Lanka Electricity Act, No. 20 of 2009, and in terms of the approval of the Cabinet of Ministers granted on 6th May, 2009 vide Cabinet Paper No. 09/0683/332/071-1 dated 30th April, 2009, the Divisional Secretaries are appointed as representatives of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka.

Pursuant to this appointment of the Divisional Secretaries as representatives of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka.—

1. The Divisional Secretaries are mandated to look into issues/objections of the relevant clearing of 'way-leaves' and installation of 'electrical lines' on lands owned by private parties by giving such parties fair hearing on behalf of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka and make recommendations to Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka on such issues/objections ; and
2. Divisional Secretaries are mandated to receive and acknowledge such issues/objections on the above from the relevant parties in writing on behalf of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka and to take appropriate actions as per above.

DEFINITIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

1. 'Way-Leaves' in relation to a land shall mean such interest in the land as consists of a right of a licensee, to install or keep installed, an electric line on, under, or over, that land and to have access to that land for the purpose of inspecting, maintaining, adjusting, repairing, altering, removing or replacing such electric line.
2. 'Electric Lines' shall mean any line whether underground or over ground which is used for carrying electricity for any purpose and includes, unless the context otherwise, requires.—
 - (a) any support for such line, including but not limited to, any structure, pole or other thing in, on, by or from which any such line is or may be supported, carried or suspended ;
 - (b) any apparatus connected to any such line for the purpose of carrying electricity ; and
 - (c) any wire, cable, tube, pipe or other similar thing (including its casing, insulator or coating), which surrounds or supports or is surrounded or supported by or is installed in close proximity to or is supported, carried or suspended in association with, any such line.
