Now therefore, I, Mahinda Rajapaksa, President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka reposing great trust and confidence in the prudence, ability and fidelity of Kaluwadewa Nimal Saliya Wimalasuriya Mathew Esquire, do by these presents appoint the said Kaluwadewa Nimal Saliya Wimalasuriya Mathew Esquire the Co-Chairman of the National Salaries and Cadres Commission to be a member of the National Administrative Reforms Council constituted in terms of the Presidential Directive referred to above.
