Happitiya the Internal Audit Assistants of the Sri Jayawardenapura General Hospital who had been placed on the salary scale of MN-5 in terms of the Public Administration Circular No. 06/2006 as effective from 22.09.2006 due to the revision of their salary scale subsequently as MT 2 - 2006 with effect from 12.12.2007 and if any injustice was caused, what should be the correct salary scale and the grade applicable to them and from which date it should be effective.

- (3) What should be the relief entitled to Messrs N. J. Karunanayake and H. A. D. T. N. Happitiya in terms of the Sections 33(a) and (b) of the Cabinet Decision No. 96/1347/120/143 dated 10.07.1996.
