Further, the approved by-law No. 06 framed for the purpose of parking motor vehicles as set out in the approved by-laws of the *Government Gazette Extraordinary*, No. 520/7 of 06 23.08.1988 complied by the Minister of Local Government, Housing and construction is rescinded from the date of coming into operation of the aforesaid by-laws within the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area from the date of publication of this notice in *Government Gazette*.

BY LAWS FOR PARKING HIRING MOTOR VEHICLES

1. These by-laws are called and known as by-laws framed for the purpose of parking, controlling, regulating hiring cars within the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area and for levying fees from such vehicles.

2. No hiring car shall be parked for the purpose of hiring at any place other than in the places approved by the Pradeshiya Sabha and notified by the Chairman and described in the 1st Schedule herein. Such places of parking may be amended and new places may be named on a resolution passed by the Pradeshiya Sabha.

3. Hiring cars shall be parked within Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha authority area complying with the 2nd by-law. In such places stipulated in the 1st Schedule, on payment of fees shown in the 2nd Schedule and also the other Government's Taxes to the Pradeshiya Sabha monthly. Such vehicles shall be registered in the Pradeshiya Sabha and fees shall be determined by the Pradeshiya Sabha from time to time and such amended fees shall be valid only after publication in the *Government Gazette*.

4. No person shall park motor vehicles in the motor car parking places shown in the 1st schedule, situated within the Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area unless on a license issued by the Chairman or by an authorized officer and this prohibition shall be affective from 6.00 a. m. to 7.00 p.m.

5. The validity of all licenses issued by the Chairman or by an officer authorized by him, under these by-laws shall expire on the last dated of a calendar month for which it is issued, unless it is cancelled earlier.

6. For the purpose of obtaining a license the owner of the driver of the vehicle shall forward an application to the form shown in the 3rd Schedule herein,

7. Whenever, a traffic warden or any person authorized by the Chairman for that purpose, call upon a owner or driver of a motor vehicle parked in a parking place, shall produce the such license for inspection.

8. The prevailing license for each month shall be obtaining before the 1st day of every month.

9. No motor vehicle shall be enter into a hiring car parking place unless there is a valid license issued by the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha.

10. Whenever a motor vehicle is removed from a hiring car parking place permanently or temporary for a period not less than 14 days the Pradeshiya Sabha shall be notified of each removed and if notice is given the relavant monthly fees shall be paid.

11. No vehicle shall be repaired or washed or cease to do so within a hiring car parking place.

12. No person shall consume liquor or behave disorderly or impolitely or cause any hinderance within a hiring parking place.

13. Contravention of any of the provisions of these by-laws shall be an offense and when convicted in a court of law having jurisdiction the imposible maximum fine and for such violation or when such offence in continously committed and when convicted or for violation after delivering a written notice by the Chairman, or by an authorized officer, or for violation continously committed the maximum of additional punishment that can imposed for each day of committing such offense shall respectively be the additional punishment specified in subsection (2) of section 122 of the Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987.

14. In addition to any other term of punishment or fine imposed by a court of law having jurisdiction, cancellation of license of a licensee is lawfull if such licensee has been convicted in a court of law having jurisdiction, on account of violation of these by-laws twice or more times and he has no right to receive any compensation.

15. In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires —

“Sabhawa” means the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha

“Chairman” means the Chairman of the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha.

“Authorized officer” means an officer authorized by the Chairmen of the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha

“Traffic warden” means an officer appointed by the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha to control traffic in the Pradeshiya Sabha.

“Motor Vehicle or hiring car” means a three wheeler, lorry, van, tractor, truck, car and hand tractor.

In the event of any inconsistency in the Sinhala, Tamil and the English texts of these by-laws, the Sinhala text shall prevail.

By-Laws relating to Itinerary Trading

1. These by-laws are called and known as by-laws for regulating, Supervising and controlling itinerary trading and for levying fees upon such trading within the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area.

2. No person shall put on sale or take here and there for sale any article unless there is a license issued by a Chairman, in any street, public garden, public ground or at any open ground, or motor vehicle parking place or any other open ground within the Kotmale Pradeshiys Sabha Authority area.

3. Every license issued under by-laws No. 02, unless it is cancelled according to by-laws No. 08 shall expire on the 31st of December of the Calendar year for which it is issued.

4. Any person who wishes to obtain a license under by-law No. 02 shall make an Application in the form shown under 1st schedule herein, to be obtained from the Pradeshiya Sabha office. Such an Application shall accompany two colour photographs, 2 x 2.5 c.m. in size showing only the bust of the applicant, and a Medical certificate issued by a recognized Medical practitioner to prove that the applicant was not suffering from any contagious or epidemic disease within the 30 days immediately preceding the date of application.

5. The License shall pay to the Pradeshiya Sabha a fee shown in the 2nd schedule herein for the purpose of by-law No. 02 afore mentioned. Such fees be determined by the Pradeshiya Sabha from time to time and shall become valid after publication of such amended fees in the *Government Gazette*.

6. The Licencee shall act in accordance with ten terms and conditions to be enforced for from time to time by the Pradeshiya Sabha in respect of itinerary trading.

7. Vendors shall refrain from itinerary trading whenever such trading has been prohibited by the resolutions of the Pradeshiya Sabha Authority Limits.

8. The Chairman has ten powers to cancel a License issued to an individual who acts in violation of the 06th and 07th by-laws and such licensee has no right to claim any compensation from the Chairman for the doing so.

9. Every itinerary trader engaged in the sale of food items shall comply with the under mentioned provisions :—

- (i) Food items carried about for sale shall be kept away from flies and dust and prevent from contacting dust and emanating any bad smell. Individuals shall not be allowed to touch foods.
- (ii) Vehicles, bicycles, carts, containers and pans, and all food utensils and such covers shall always be kept clean.
- (iii) Papers and such other materials used for wrapping items shall be clean and suitable for that purpose.
- (iv) Clean instruments and tools shall be used for handling and serving foods.
- (v) Fire shall not be used causing any danger or hindrance to any individual or individuals.
- (vi) Garbage and polluted water shall not be thrown away in public places and shall make arrangements to dispose them under hygienic conditions.
- (vii) Itinerant traders during the time of engaging in itinerant trading shall wear the identify card issued by the Chairman as visible to consumers.

10. Itinerary traders shall not sell meat or fish of an animal or animals mentioned in the Butcher's Ordinance and wildlife Act.

11. Any License-holder who possesses a license for sale of cooked and prepared food items under these by-laws shall be liable and subject to provisions of the food Act.

12. If a license-holder is suffering from a contagious or epidemic disease or if such a patient is resident in his household or if the license-holder is nursing such a patient, he shall immediately stop such itinerary trading and resume trading on the expiration of the contagious time period of the disease.

13. License-holder shall not carry out his trading business causing hindrance to any individual walking in a street, pavement, or in an open place.

14. No article shall be carried here and there for sale or trading except between the time period of 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. in any day by a license-holder.

15. The Chairman has the power to take into custody the trading articles of any person who violates the 13th by-law and take action regarding such articles in a manner determined by him.

16. The license-holder shall not transmit to any other person the license issued to him.

17. Violation or contravening any of the provisions of these by-laws shall be an offence and when convicted in a court of law having jurisdiction, the maximum fine that can be imposed for such violation or when such an offence is continuously committed and when convicted, or for continuously violation after delivering a written notice on him by the Chairman or by any other Authority officer, or for violation continuously committed, the maximum of additional punishments that can be imposed for each day of such violation, shall respectively be the maximum fine and maximum of the additional punishment specified in subsection (2) of section 122 of Pradeshiya Sabha Acts, No. 15 of 1987.

18. In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires—

“Chairman” Means the Chairman of the Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha.

“Sabhawa” Means Kotmale Pradeshiya Sabha.

“Itinerary Trading” Means sale of trading articles by carrying them from place to place without any specified place or taking such articles here and there in a Motor bicycle, Push bicycle, Three wheeler, Motor van or in a Mechanically or Manually driven vehicle built for the purpose of Itinerary Trading.

“Authorized Officer” Means any officer authorized by the Chairman.

In the event of any inconsistency in the Sinhala, Tamil and English texts of these by-laws, the Sinhala text shall prevail.

BY-LAWS OF AKURANA PRADESHIYA SABHA

IT is hereby notified that, I, Sarath Ekanayake, the Minister in charge of the subject of Local Government in the Central Province, by virtue of powers vested in me under subsection (1) of section 123 of Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987 to be read with subsection (i) of subsection 2 of the Provincial Council Act, No. 12 of 1989 (consequential Provisions) has approved the under mentioned by-laws framed by Akurana Pradeshiya Sabha, according to powers vested in the said Pradeshiya Sabha under subsection (X) of section 126 of the said Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987 to be read with subsection (I) of section 122 of the same Acts and the said by-laws shall come into force within the said Pradeshiya Sabha authority area from the date of publication of this notification in the *Government Gazette*.

Further, I, Sarath Ekanayake, the Minister in Charge of the Subject of Local Government in the Central Province do hereby notify, by virtue of powers vested in me under subsection 4(1) of the standard by-laws Act, No. 06 of 1952 to be read with subsection (1) of section 2 of the Provincial Council Act, No. 12 of 1989 (consequential provisions), that I have rescinded the by-laws No. 28 framed for the purpose of of itinerary trading, published along with approved by-laws of the *Gazette Extra-Ordinary* No. 520/7 dated 23.08.1988 complied by the Minister of Local Government, Housing and construction from the date of coming into force the aforesaid by-laws. Further the said by-laws shall cease to be affective within the Akurana Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area from the date of publication of this notice in *Government Gazette*.

By-Laws relating to Itinerary Trading

1. These by-laws are called and known as by-laws for regulating, Supervising and controlling itinerary trading and for levying fees upon such trading within the Akurana Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area.

2. No person shall put on sale or take here and there for sale any article unless there is a license issued by a Chirman, in any street, public garden, public ground or at any open ground, or motor vehicle parking place or any other open ground within the Akurana Pradeshiya Sabha Authority area.

3. Every license issued under by-laws No. 02, unless it is cancelled according to by-laws No. 08 shall expire on the 31st of December of the Calendar year for which it is issued.

4. Any person who wishes to obtain a license under by-law No. 02, shall make an Application in the form shown under 1st schedule herein, to be obtained from the Pradeshiya Sabha office. Such an Application shall accompany two colour photographs, 2 x 2.5 c.m. in size showing only the bust of the applicant, and a Medical certificate issued by a recognized Medical practitioner to prove that the applicant was not suffering from any contiguous or epidemic disease within the 30 days immediately preceding the date of application.

5. The License shall pay to the Pradeshiya Sabha a fee shown in the 2nd schedule herein for the purpose of by-law No. 02 afore mentioned. Such fees be determined by the Pradeshiya Sabha from time to time and shall become valid after publication of such amended fees in the *Government Gazette*.

6. The Licencee shall act in accordance with ten terms and conditions to be enforced for from time to time by the Pradeshiya Sabha in respect of itinerary trading.

7. Vendors shall refrain from itinerary trading whenever such trading has been prohibited by the resolutions of the Pradeshiya Sabha Authority Limits.

8. The Chairman has ten powers to cancel a License issued to an individual who acts in violation of the 06th and 07th by-laws and such licensee has no right to claim any compensation from the Chairman for the doing so.

9. Every itinerary trader engaged in the sale of food items shall comply with the under mentioned provisions :—

- (i) Food items carried about for sale shall be kept away from flies and dust and prevent from contacting dust and emanating any bad smell. Individuals shall not be allowed to touch foods.
- (ii) Vehicles, bicycles, carts, containers and pans, and all food utensils and such covers shall always be kept clean.
- (iii) Papers and such other materials used for wrapping items shall be clean and suitable for that purpose.
- (iv) Clean instruments and tools shall be used for handling and serving foods.
- (v) Fire shall not be used causing any danger or hindrance to any individual or individuals.
- (vi) Garbage and polluted water shall not be thrown away in public places and shall make arrangements to dispose them under hygienic conditions.
- (vii) Itinerant traders during the time of engaging in itinerant trading shall wear the identify card issued by the Chairman as visible to consumers.

10. Itinerary traders shall not sell meat or fish of an animal or animals mentioned in the Butcher's Ordinance and wildlife Act.

11. Any License-holder who possesses a license for sale of cooked and prepared food items under these by-laws shall be liable and subject to provisions of the food Act.

12. If a license-holder is suffering from a contagious or epidemic disease or if such a patient is resident in his household or if the license-holder is nursing such a patient, he shall immediately stop such itinerary trading and resume trading on the expiration of the contagious time period of the disease.

13. License-holder shall not carry out his trading business causing hindrance to any individual walking in a street, pavement, or in an open place.

14. No article shall be carried here and there for sale or trading except between the time period of 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. in any day by a license-holder.

15. The Chairman has the power to take into custody the trading articles of any person who violates the 13th by-law and take action regarding such articles in a manner determined by him.

16. The license-holder shall not transmit to any other person the license issued to him.

17. Violation or contravening any of the provisions of these by-laws shall be an offence and when convicted in a court of law having jurisdiction, the maximum fine that can be imposed for such violation or when such an offence is continuously committed and when convicted, or for continuously violation after delivering a written notice on him by the Chairman or by any other Authority officer, or for violation continuously committed, the maximum of additional punishments that can be imposed for each day of such violation, shall respectively be the maximum fine and maximum of the additional punishment specified in sub-section (2) of section 122 of Pradeshiya Sabha Acts, No. 15 of 1987.

18. In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires—

“Chairman” - Means the Chairman of the Akurana Pradeshiya Sabha.

“Sabhawa” - Means Akurana Pradeshiya Sabha.

“Itinerary Trading” - Means sale of trading articles by carrying them from place to place without any specified place or taking such articles here and there in a Motor bicycle, Push bicycle, Three wheeler, Motor van or in a Mechanically or Manually driven vehicle built for the purpose of Itinerary Trading.

“Authorized Officer” - Means any officer authorized by the Chairman.

In the event of any inconsistency in the Sinhala, Tamil and English texts of these by-laws, the Sinhala text shall prevail.
