AMENDMENT OF SECTION 18 OF THE SERVICE MINUTE OF SRI LANKA
EDUCATIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE

PUBLIC Service Commission has decided to amend Section 18 of the Minute of Sri Lanka Educational Administrative Service published in the *Extraordinary Gazette* No. 1225/32 dated 01st March, 2002 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows :

“Officers in Class II of the Sri Lanka Educational Administrative Service who possess a Degree from a recognized University or who have passed a professional or other examination considered by the Public Service Commission as equivalent to such Degree and who have completed an active period of service of not less than ten years in the Sri Lanka Administrative Education Service will be eligible for promotion to Class I of such Service. Their qualifications commensurating with the Service Minute will be examined based on the information called for through a format sent to the respective officers constituting of a number of officers not more than three times the number of vacancies as per the seniority list updated once in every six months, after such information is certified as correct by an appropriate authority. If the relevant officers who are to be considered for the vacancies on the respective dates have not fulfilled the qualifications in terms of the Service Minute action will accordingly be taken to notify them to that effect in writing. Those officers who meet with the required qualifications will be called for the interview held for promotions. The names of the officers who should be promoted to Class I on seniority and merit will be recommended to the Public Service Commission by an Interview Board appointed by the Public Service Commission consisting of the Secretary of the Ministry of the Minister in charge of the subject of Education in chair and two other Cabinet Secretaries. A marking scheme approved by the Public Service Commission shall be applied for interview board evaluation”.

Note.— (Valid only relating to filling of vacancies existing up to 01.01.2007) “According to the above amendment the information submitted for the first time by the officers who are qualified for promotion to Class I according to the order of the Seniority List of the Class II of the Sri Lanka Educational Administrative Service will be considered for filling up of the vacancies existing on 01.06.2000 – 01.01.2007.
