SCHEDULE

The decisions made by the Wages Board for the Match Manufacturing Trade and set out in, the schedule to the notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9708 of 30th May, 1947 as varied from time to time and last varied by the notification published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1470/27 of 1st December 2006, shall be further varied by the substitution of the following new part for Part II of that schedule.

PART II

THE MINIMUM RATE OF THE WAGES FOR TIME WORK

The minimum rate of wages for time work for a normal working day applicable to workers in Column I, shall be at the rates set out in the corresponding entry in Column II.

<i>Grade II</i>	
Cross-cutting by hand, cross-cutting by machine driver, splint levelling, cutting outside, rim and bottom veneers by cutter, inner box making by machine, sharpening knives and tools by machine by helper, paraffining by hand emptying frames, side-painting of boxes, checking filled boxes, Band-rolling by machine driver, mixing composition for painting sides of boxes, outer box making by machine, feeding boxes by machine for box filling, dipping sticks in chemical composition by hand.	202.00

The work (in the match manufacturing trade) of all workers not specified in Grade I or Grade II, above other than the work of a watcher..	200.00

SCHEDULE

The decision made by the Wages Board for the Coconut Growing Trade and set out in the Schedule to the notification published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9971 of April 30, 1949 as varied from time to time and last varied from the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1494/15 of 25.04.2007 shall be further varied in that Schedule as follows:

(1) In the Part II of that schedule in the minimum wage for piece work applicable to the workers shall be as follows:

<i>Process</i>	<i>Rate (Rs.)</i>
(1) In the raising and maintenance of Plantation plucking nuts	- 533.75 per 1000 trees
(2) In the manufacture of Copra-Husking nuts, Splitting nuts Copra curing and sorting	- 154.75 per 1000 nuts

PART III

(2) *Processes*

- (a) The raising and maintenance of a Coconut Plantaion
- (b) The manufacture of Copra

The minimum rate of wages for time work in relation to above processes shall be:

Male or Female worker – Rs. 206.75 per a day

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the preceding provisions of this Part the minimum rate of wages for time work for any worker engaged in cattle keeping on Sunday shall be one and a half times the minimum rate of wages for the work fixed for such worker in respect of a normal working day.

The minimum rate of wages for time work in relation to –

- (a) the work of a Conductor,
- (b) the work of a Watcher shall be
