BY virtue of Powers vested in me under Sub-Section (2) in Section 2 of the Entertainment Tax Ordinance constituting Authority 267 and read with paragraph (a) of Sub-Section (1) in Section 2 of the Provincial Councils (Consequential Provisions) Act, No. 12 of 1989, I, Prasanna Ranatunga, the Chief Minister and the Minister of Finance and Planning, Law and Order, Education, Land, Local Government and Provincial Administration, Electricity and Power, Manpower and Employment and Economic Promotion of the Western Province, Provincial Council, do by this order declare to the general public that I have approved the under - mentioned proposal adopted by the Kaduwela Municipal Council under Decision No. 5(1)-01/Mu/0009 at the General Meeting held on 08th September 2011.

Proposal

“Every person engaged in certain entertainment activity pertaining to matters contained in Entertainment Tax Ordinance constituting Authority 267 within the authority of Kaduwela Municipal Council ; when such activity relates to ;

(a) a movie screening ;

(i) from January 01st of 2012 to 31st December 2012, and amount equal to seven point five percent (7.5%) from the money charged from persons admitted to such screenings ;

(ii) from January 01st of 2013 and onward, an amount equal to fifteen percent (15%) from the money charged from persons admitted to such screenings ; and

(b) when such activity constitutes other entertainment activity except movie screening, an amount equal to twenty five percent (25%) from the money charged from persons admitted to such activities ;

shall be imposed and charged as Entertainment Tax as per powers conferred to the Kaduwela Municipal Council by Section 2 of the aforesaid Entertainment Ordinance.”
