#### THE ANTIQUITIES ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 188)

REGULATION made by the Minister of National Heritage under Section 47 of the Antiquities Ordinance (Chapter 188)

#### Regulations

The Antiquities Rewards Fund Regulations published in *Gazette* No. 1,653 of May 7, 2010, is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the repeal of regulation 3 of that regulations and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“3. The following persons shall be entitled to be paid a monetary reward from the Antiquities Rewards Fund :—

- (a) the Chief Inspector of Police or any officer below the rank of a Chief Inspector, or any officer of the Sri Lanka Customs involved in the detection of the unlawful export of any antiquity ;
- (b) the Regional Director of the Department of Archaeology or a staff-grade officer of the Department representative involved in enforcement activities of the Department of Archaeology ;
- (c) a public servant below the rank of a staff officer or an officer of the Archeological Department, involved in inspecting relevant sites or antiquities which are subject to legal proceedings ;
- (d) the Director – General, Department of Archaeology or any officer working in the Head Office of the Archaeological Department, who appear in legal proceedings on the direction of the Director – General ;
- (e) a legal officer or an assistant legal officer of the Department of Archaeology who appears in the legal proceedings, for the Department;
- (f) an officer involved in maintenance and administration of the Archaeological Reward fund of the Department of Archaeology ;

(g) an officer attached to the “Special Unit for, the Prevention of the Destruction of Antiquities, who is involved in the preparation and maintenance of the reports, relating to court proceedings ;

and

(h) an informant who provides information in order to ensure the protecting of antiquities.”;

(2) by the repeal of regulation 7 of such regulations and the substitution therefor of the following regulation :—

“7. The Director - General of Archaeology shall reward any police officer only on the recommendation of the Director of Crimes. Department of Police.”;

(3) by the repeal of the First Schedule and the Second Schedule to these regulations and substitution therefor of the following Schedules :—

(e) A legal officer or an assistant legal officer of the Department of Archaeology who appears in the legal proceedings, for the Department.	10%
(f) An officer involved in maintenance and administration of the Archaeological Reward fund of the Department of Archaeology.	5%
(g) An officer attached to the “Special unit for, the prevention of the Destruction of Antiquities who is involved in the preparation and maintenance of the reports, relating to court proceedings ; and	5%
(h) An informant who provides information in order to ensure the protecting of antiquities.	15%
