Regulations

These Regulations may be cited as Motor Traffic Fees Regulations 2011 and shall be effective from 14.11.2011.

(a) Definition :

Car, Ambulance, Hearse, Jeep or other private passenger vehicles mean a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for the carriage of not more than nine persons (including the driver) and their effects.

(b) Definition :

- (1) Lorry - A Lorry means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods and include a trailer so constructed or adapted.
- (2) Gross vehicle weight means the unloaded weight of a vehicle added to the weight of the load, if may, that may be carried by the vehicle including both passengers and goods.

(c) *Definition :*

- (1) A dual purpose vehicle is a motor vehicle designed and constructed for the purpose of carrying both persons and goods contemporaneously provide, that the number of persons shall not exceed the number authorized for a private passenger vehicle. (nine)

(d) Definition :

- (1) Land vehicle means any mechanically propelled vehicle (with a trailer) intended wholly or mainly for use on land for an agricultural or construction purpose.
- (2) Agriculture Tractor means a motor vehicle constructed for the purpose of another for an agricultural or construction purpose.
- (3) Agriculture trailer includes every description of vehicles attached to and drawn by a motor vehicle and used for an agricultural or construction purpose.
- (4) Hand Tractor means a two-wheeled tractor fitted with a trailer.

(e) Definition :

- (1) Public passenger transport vehicle includes an omnibus or a motor coach or motor wagon used for public passenger transport.
- (2) A Motor Coach means a motor vehicle constructed for the carriage of more than nine persons (including driver) and their effects.
- (3) Omnibus means a motor coach registered as an omnibus.
- (4) Motor Wagon means a vehicle constructed or adapted in Sri Lanka for the purpose of carrying not less than nine persons (including the driver)
- (5) Private coach means a motor coach registered as a private coach.

(f) *Definition :*

- (1) Motor Cycle - A Vehicle designed and constructed to travel on 2 wheels but which, may have a side car attached with one extra wheel.
- (2) Motor Tricycle - A Vehicle designed to travel on Three wheels constructed or adapted wholly or mainly for the carriage of persons.
- (3) Motor Tricycle Van - A vehicle designed to travel on three wheels constructed wholly or mainly for the carriage of goods.
 - (a) Annual Licence fee Motor Cycles Rs. 450.00
 - (b) Annual Licence fee for Motor Tricycles and Motor Tricycle Vans Rs. 550.00
 - (c) Annual Licence fee for Motor Vehicles in "A" to "Z" series Rs. 100.00
 - (d) The vehicle using electronic, gas or other alternative fuel shall be 50% of petrol fees applicable to vehicle of the same class and weight.
 - (e) Monthly licence fee for a vehicle brought by a foreigner into the country for his use during his stay here Rs. 500.00

Penalties :

- (1) As the licensing year of a motor vehicle commences from the day and the month on the date of the first registration of that motor vehicle, be made within three working days of the corresponding day of the corresponding month (hereinafter called "the due date for the payment of licence fee") of the year in respect of which the licence is applied for When a period as not exceeding 6 months has elapsed after the due date of payment of licence fees - 10% of the prescribed annual fee.
- (2) Licence for a newly registered vehicle shall be taken within 7 days, and if the said period is exceed 10% of the prescribed annual fee.
- (3) When a period of over 6 months but less than 12 months has elapsed after the due date for payment of licence fees 20% of the prescribed annual fee.
- (4) When a period is over 12 months has elapsed after the due date for payments of Licence fees 30% of the prescribed annual fee.
