And Whereas, the aforesaid original Directive was amended by Presidential Directives made from time to time and the composition of the members of the National Administrative Reforms Council was revised by the said Directives;

And Whereas, since the need for the said Council to be made more widely representative has been identified, I am of the view that the Board of Members of the Council currently in operation should be ceased to hold office and a newly - constituted Board of Members appointed instead ;

And now, therefore, I, Mahinda Rajapaksa, President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, in pursuance of the provisions of Article 33 of the Constitution, do hereby, reposing great trust and confidence in your prudence, ability and fidelity, by these presents, appoint you the said ;

And I, do hereby authorize the National Administrative Reforms Council to issue directions, make inquiries and investigate such matters as may be necessary in relation to the execution of the tasks it is hereby entrusted with.
