PART I : SECTION (I) — GENERAL

Government Notifications

THE ARMY ACT

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 155 of the Army Act, (Chapter 357) read with Article 144(2) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

Regulations

The Army Pension and Gratuity Code, 1981, Published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 562/11 of 15 th June 1989, as amended from time to time, is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) By the addition of the following Paragraphs immediately after Paragraph 29 (h) :

29 (h) (i) Where an officer of the Volunteer Force including a Quarter Master who has completed five years reckonable service dies whilst in service, the dependants of such officer may be granted a death gratuity as mentioned in Regulation 17 of the aforesaid code as in the case of a Regular Officer.

(2) By the addition of the following Paragraph immediately after Paragraph 29 (h) (i) :

29 (h) (ii) Where a Male or Female soldier of the Volunteer Force who has completed five years reckonable service dies whilst in service, the dependants of such soldier may be granted a death gratuity mentioned in Regulation 26 of the aforesaid code as in the case of a Male or Female soldier of the of Regular Force.

(3) By the addition of the following Paragraph immediately after Paragraph 29 (h) (ii) :—

29 (h) (iii) Where an officer of the Volunteer Force including a Quarter Master who has more than ten years but less than twenty years reckonable service is invalided for causes not within his control **as determined by an Army Medical Board** such person may be granted a pension as mentioned in Regulation 10 of the aforesaid Code as in the case of a Regular Officer.

(4) By the addition of the following Paragraph immediately after Paragraph 29 (h) (iii) :-

29 (h) (iv) Where a Male soldier who has at least twelve years but less than twenty - two years reckonable service or a Female soldier who has at least twelve years but less than fifteen years reckonable service is invalidated for causes not within his or her control as determined by an Army Medical Board such person may be granted a pension as mentioned in Regulation 22 of the aforesaid Code calculated with effect from a date not earlier than 1 st September, 1981 as in the case of Regular Male of Female soldier.

(5) By the addition of the following Paragraph immediately after Paragraph 29 (h) (iv) :-

29 (h) (v) Where a disabled soldier of the Volunteer Force who has more than two and half years but less than ten years reckonable service before been declared disabled by an Army Medical Board such person may be granted a gratuity computed at the rate of 1/24 of the salary for each completed month of reckonable service as mentioned in Regulation 25 (7) of the aforesaid Code.

THE NAVY ACT (CHAPTER 358)

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 161 of the Navy Act, (Chapter 358) read with Article 44(2) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

Regulations

The Navy Pension and Gratuity Code, 1981, Published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 654/10 of 20th March 1991, as amended from time to time, is hereby amended as follows :-

1. Renumbering the sub paragraph (2) of regulation 12 as sub paragraph (2) (a); and by Adding sub paragraph (2) (b) immediately after the renumbered sub paragraph (2) (a) of the regulation 12.

12. (2) (b) Where a male officer or a lady officer of the Regular Force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has a reckonable service not less than 2 years but less than 10 years is invalidated for causes not within his / her control as determined by a Naval Medical Board may be granted a gratuity calculated at the rate of 1/24 th of his / her salary for each completed month of service.

2. Renumbering the sub paragraph (2) of regulation 22 as sub paragraph (2) (a); and by adding sub paragraph (2) (b) immediately after the renumbered sub paragraph (2) (a) of regulation 22.

22. (2) (b) Where a seaman or a women sailor of the Regular Force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has a reckonable service not less than 2 1/2 years but less than 10 years is invalidated for causes not within his / her control as determined by a Naval Medical Board may be granted a gratuity calculated at the rate of 1/24th of his / her salary for each completed month of service.

3. Inserting following regulation as 26 (5) (b) immediately after regulation 26 (5) (a) and by renumbering existing regulation 26 (5) (b) to (e) as 26 (5) (c) to (f).

26. (5) (b) Where a male officer or lady officer of the Volunteer Force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has at least ten years reckonable service but less than twenty years reckonable service in case of a male officer and fifteen years reckonable service in case of a lady officer is invalidated for causes not within his / her control as determined by a Naval Medical Board may be granted pension calculated in the manner provided in regulation 4.

4. Renumbering the sub paragraph (6) of regulation 26 as sub paragraph (6) (a) ; and by adding following paragraph as sub paragraph (6) (b) immediately after the renumbered sub paragraph (6) (a) of regulation 26.

26 (6) (b) Where a seaman or a woman sailor of the Volunteer force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has at least twelve years reckonable service but less than twenty two years reckonable service in case of a seaman and fifteen years reckonable service in case of a woman sailor is invalidated for causes not within his / her control as determined by a Naval Medical Board, may be granted a pension calculated in the manner provided in regulation 18 (2).

5. Renumbering the sub paragraph (9) of regulation 26 as sub paragraph (9) (a); and by adding following paragraphs as sub paragraph 26 (9) (b) to (d) immediately after the renumbered sub paragraph (9) (a) of regulation 26.

26 (9) (b) Where a male officer or a lady officer of the Volunteer Force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has a reckonable service not less than 2 years but less than 10 years is invalidated for causes not within his / her control as determined by a Naval Medical Board may be granted a gratuity calculated at the rate of 1/24th of his / her salary for each completed month of service.

26 (9) (c) Where a seaman or a woman sailor of the Volunteer Force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has a reckonable service not less than 2 1/2 years but less than 10 years reckonable service is invalidated for causes not within his / her control as determined by a Naval Medical Board may be granted a gratuity calculated at the rate of 1/24th of his / her salary for each completed month of service.

26 (9) (d) Where a male officer or a lady officer and a seaman or a woman sailor of the Volunteer force of the Sri Lanka Navy who has completed five years reckonable service, dies whilst in service, the dependants of such person may be granted an award under regulations 14 (1) and 23 (1) in addition to any award payable under the regulations relating to disability pension.

THE SRI LANKA AIR FORCE ACT (CHAPTER 359)

REGULATIONS made by the President under Section 29 and 155 of the Air Force Act, (Chapter 359) read with Article 44 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

Regulations

Published as special *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 645/8 of 16 th January 1991. The SLAF Pensions and Gratuities Code 1981 shall be further amended as follows :—

(1) The following Paragraph shall apply in addition to Paragraph (3) of Regulation 14 :—

14 (4) Where a Volunteer Officer, who has completed five years service dies whilst in Service, the dependents of such Officer may be granted the Death Gratuity in the same manner as in the case of a Regular Officer in accordance with the Regulation 14 relating to this provision.

(2) The following Paragraph shall apply in addition Para (3) of Regulation 23 :—

23 (4) Where a Volunteer Airman / Airwoman who has completed five years service dies whilst in service, the dependents of such Airman / Airwoman may be granted the Death Gratuity in the same manner as in the case of a Regular Airman / Airwoman in accordance with regulation 23 relating to this provision.

(3) The following Paragraph shall apply in addition to Para (2) in Regulation 8 :—

8(3) Where a Volunteer Officer who has completed more than ten years but less than twenty years of reckonable Service is invalidated due to health condition, which is beyond his control as determined by an Air Force Medical Board, may be paid a pension in the manner same as in the event of a Regular Officer in accordance with the Regulation 08 relating to this proviosn.

(4) The following Paragraph shall apply in addition to Para (2) in Regulation 19 :—

19 (3) Where a Volunteer Airman / Airwoman who has completed more than twelve years reckonable service but less than twenty two years and twenty years service respectively is invalidated due to health condition which is beyond his /her control as determined by an Air Force Medical Board, He / She may be paid a Pension in the manner as in the case of a Regular Airmen / Airwomen in accordance with the regulation 19 relating to this provisions.

(5) The following Paragraph shall apply in addition to sub Paragraph (6) of the Regulation 12 :—

12(7) Where an Officer who retires due to a Medical Reason beyond his / her control.

(a) He / She has a reckonable service period of at least two years but less than ten years, he / She is eligible for a Gratuity equallant to 1/24th of his / her salary for each completed month of service.

(6) 12 (8) Where an Officer who has more than two years of reckonable service but less than ten years of reckonable service, who is disabled whilst on Volunteer Service shall be eligible for the Gratuity of 1/24th of the salary for each for each completed month of service.

(7) The following Paragraph shall apply in addition to Paragraph (6) of the Regulation 22 :—

22 (7) Where an Airman / Airwoman who retires due to a Mediacal Reasons, beyond, his / her control.

(a) He / She has a reckonable service period of at least two years but less than ten years, he / she is eligible for a Gratuity equallant to 1/24th of his / her salary for each completed month of service.

(8) 22(8) Where an Airman / Airwoman who has more than two and half years of reckonable service but less than ten years of reckonable service, who becomes disabled whilst on Volunteer Service shall be eligible for a Gratuity equivalent to 1/24 of his / her salary for each completed month of service.
