RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF CO-ORDINATOR, BUDDHIST AFFAIRS

APPLICATIONS are entertained from Graduates for the Post of Co-ordinator, Buddhist Affairs in the Department of Buddhist Affairs, Ministry of Buddha Sasana. The Commissioner General of Buddhist Affairs, invites graduates who are really interested in taking up duties to apply for the post only after making a through study of the following particulars :—

1. *Duties assigned to the post :*

- (i) Activities connected to Buddhism (including Sasarakshaka Mandalas);
- (ii) Educational Activities of Dhamma Schools ;
- (iii) Organizing activities to make the temple the focus of village while promoting the co-ordination of the temple and the village ;
- (iv) Activities in regard to the temple and the Bhikkus ;
- (v) Other Buddhist activities ;
- (vi) Co-ordinating activities of divisional offices Institutions with the Department.

2. *Number of post and Serving Stations :*— Number of post vacant is 580. There will be two post at the Divisional Secretary's Division, one post in District Secretary's Office and 24 post in the main office. The commissioner general of Buddhist Affairs can change this order of placement taking in to consideration service requirement and other matters. Officers thus recruited are obliged to serve in any part of the Island mentioned above as directed by the Commissioner general of Buddhist Affairs. The new recruits have no claim to request for a transfer till the completion of 03 years with effect from the date of first appointment.

3. Qualifications required :

- (i). *Age Limit* .— Applicants should not be less than 18 years and more than 45 years on the last date of receiving applications. The upper age limit will not apply to those who are already in Public Service, Provincial Public Service holding permanent posts.

Dhamma School Teachers' Certificate Examination - 2005(2548 B.E.)

THE Commissioner General of Buddhist affairs entertains applications for the Dhamma School Teachers' Certificate Examination to be held for the second time by the Department of Buddhist Affairs under the auspices of the Ministry of Buddha Sasana and the guidance of the all Ceylon Buddhist Congress.

Applicants who have satisfied their eligibility in conformity with the following instructions should submit applications prepared on A4 size paper.

1. *Objective :*

- (i) To provide the basic qualifications to those teachers who are at present engaged in Dhamma School teaching.
- (ii) In order to appreciate the services rendered by teachers in Dhamma Schools who engage in teaching on their own accord to issue a letter of appointment, Identity Card and thereby, satisfy minimum qualification entitled to permanency.
- (iii) Encouraging teachers who are devoid of even the preliminary qualifications to achieve knowledge in higher educational activities.
- (iv) To stabilize a social recognition for Dhamma School teachers and thereby make their service appreciable among the masses.

2. *The manner the examination is held and its date of holding the same.*— The examination will be held in 20 centers over 20 districts of the island on 23rd July, 2005 under the direct supervision of the Department of Buddhist Affairs. The examination will be held only in the Sinhala Medium.

3. *Manner of applying for the examination :*

- (i) An application prepared according to the following form should be submitted.
- (ii) All applications not certified by the Head Master will be rejected.
- (iii) The last date of receiving applications is 15th May, 2005. Applications received thereafter will be rejected.
