- 4.) Certificate issued by the competent authority / responsible organization of the country of origin of quality of the radioactive material imported. (This is required for the material imported for diagnostic & therapy)
- 5.) If a sealed source is imported, letters from the user and supplier that they undertake to return back the source to manufacturer for disposal should be attached.

I hereby certify that the information furnished above is correct to the best of my knowledge. I am aware of the radiological safety precautions to be observed during the handling of the package and should ensure that all the precautions stipulated by the Atomic Energy Authority will be duly observed.
