Applications, prepared in accordance with the specimen form appended to this Notification, should be posted under registered cover to reach Secretary, Ministry of Cultural Affairs and National Heritage, 8th Floor, Sethsripaya, Battaramulla on or before 20.09.2005. The applications, received after the closing date will be rejected without any notification. This Departmental candidates shall submit their application through the Director General of Archaeology.

02. Post of Director :

- (i) Director (Excavation and Museum)
- (ii) Director (Epigraphy and Numismatics)
- (iii) Director (Exploration and Documentation)
- (iv) Director (Maintenance) Engineers, who are not in the Sri Lanka Engineering Service.

Separate applications should be sent for each post. On the top left hand corner of the envelope, enclosing the application, the name of the post, that the application is forwarded for should be clearly marked.

03. Condition of Service :

This post is permanent and entitled to a contributory pension under the contributory pension fund.

Exception :

If a person who held a pensionable post before 01.01.2003, is recruited to this post, such a person will be entitled to a pension under the pensions minute and required to contribute to the "Widows/Widowers' and Orphans Pension Scheme".

04. Condition of Employment :

Sections 10 to 12 of chapter II of Establishment Code are applicable.

07. *Other Qualifications (Age Limit) :*

Should not be less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age. (The upper age limit does not apply to officers already in the Public/Provincial Public Service).

08. *Method of recruitment to the Service :*

08.1 Departmental candidates will be recruited for the Posts of Director upon the results of a written and professional test, conducted by the Secretary, Cultural and National Heritage. When vacancies can not be filled out of the applicants of the Department, recruitment will be made through a competitive examination. Recruitment will be made on the maximum marks, obtained through a written and professional test. Selections would be made after calling for applications through the government *gazette* and newspaper notifications and those who have the qualifications will be selected through a professional test based on the procedure approved by the Public Service Commission in giving marks.

08.2 Subjects for the test for external and internal candidates are as follows : —

(i) Written Test :

- * History of Sri Lanka

08.3 Method of Marking for the written test

02 Papers 03 hours for each paper, 200 marks at the rate of 100 marks per one paper Minimum of 40% marks for each subject should be obtained for a pass.

08.4 Method of marking for the professional test.

100 marks for this test. Minimum of 40% marks should be obtained for a pass. Method of marking, approved by the public Service Commission time to time will be based for this purpose.

09. Applications forwarded expecting the results will be rejected. Required qualification should be acquired as at the closing date of applications and improper and illegible applications will be rejected without giving any reason.
