This is a comprehensive course designed for those who are having a basic knowledge in offset sheet fed litho press operations, who wish to enhance skills in qualitative sheet fed press operations.

The course is also useful for those who are in the industry and the newcomers who wish to take up careers in the Printing industry. The course will be in Sinhala medium and will be spread over 08 months consisting of theory and practical class.

- * Damping and Inking systems
- * Paper and ink requirements
- * Cylinder packing and pressure control
- * Press register system and control
- * Press troubleshooting

02. Certificate Course in Offset Lithography :

The course is designed to provide the knowledge and skills to improve the quality and productivity in the offset litho press room.

The course is designed for those who are in the industry in Operational, Supervision and Managerial areas.

The course will also be useful for newcomers who wish to take up printing as a career.

The course will be conducted in Sinhala and English Languages and spread over 8 months with classes in theory and practicals.
