Two Year Diploma Course in Animal Husbandry

APPLICATIONS are invite for the admission of the students to the above mentioned Two Year Diploma Course in Animal Husbandry conducted by this Department.

01. Particulars of the Diploma Course are as follows:

- 1.1 The course will be conducted in Sinhala, Tamil and English Media.
- 1.2 The Diploma Course is purely a Vocational Course and is intended for those who wish either to be self employed in livestock industry or to those who seek suitable

employment after completing the course successfully. However, the Department is not prepared to provide employment to those who complete this course.

1.3 Lodging will be provided to the students during the period of training but food will not supplied.

1.4 Some times the classes may be held on Saturdays and Sundays and the students will be allowed to leave the hostels in one weekend of a month.

2. *Mode of Selection:-* Selection of Students will be done by a written examination and an interview. Written examination will consist of two papers each will be of 01 hour duration on the following:

- i. Animal Husbandry - Multiple choice and short questions prepared according to the livestock Part in the syllabus of Agriculture for G. C. E. (O/L).
- ii. General Knowledge
- iii. English - Prepared according to the syllabus of the English Language for G. C. E. (O/L).

3. Minimum Qualifications for the Admission:

3.1 Should be citizens of Sri Lanka;

3.2 They should not be less than 17 years and not more than 25 years of age as at 01.03.2005 (A copy of the Birth certificate should be attached).

3.3.1 Should have passed General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) in one sitting with Six subjects including Credit passes for Language or Literature, Mathematics, Science and another subject and;

3.3.2 Should have passed General Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) Examination in one sitting including two science subjects out of the following subjects — Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Agriculture and English. The copies of the educational certificates should be attached to the application. Applications which do not comply with this requirement will be rejected. The originals of the certificates should be submitted at the interview.

**** Those who have studied in the Maths stream in the G.C.E. (A/L) cannot apply for this Diploma.**

3.3.3 If the candidate wishes to follow the course in the English Medium he/she should obtain a credit pass for English language at G. C. E. (O/L) examination.

4. If any information herein provided by an applicant is found to be untrue or incorrect his/her studentship will be terminated forthwith and he/she is liable to pay the expenses incurred by the Department

on account of his/her training to the Director General, Department of Animal Production and Health. The Director General, Department of Animal Production and Health reserves the right to determine these expenses.

5. Applications prepared in accordance with the specimen provided below should be forwarded under registered cover addressed to the "Director (Human Resources Development), Department of Animal Production and Health, P. O. Box 13, Getambe, Peradeniya on or before 28.02.2005. The words "Admission to Diploma in Animal Husbandry" and the District where the applicant resides should be written on the top left hand corner of the envelope. Applicants should themselves prepare their applications. Candidates should forward a Money Order with the application to the value of Rs. 150 as examination fees in favour of "Director General, Department of Animal Production and Health" to be withdrawn from Post Office, Peradeniya.

6. Applications which do not comply with the requirement of this notice will be rejected without any acknowledgement to the applicant. The examination fees will not be refunded.

RECRUITMENT TO THE TRAINING GRADE IN THE POST OF RAILWAY GUARD OF THE SRI LANKA TECHNOLOGICAL SERVICE DEPARTMENT OF RAILWAYS

APPLICATIONS are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka who satisfy the necessary qualifications stipulated in this notification for the Training Grade in the post of Railway Guard of the Department of the Railways. Recruitment to the existing vacancies in the grade of Railway Guards will be made in order of merit performed by the candidates at an open competitive examination held in accordance with the conditions of Public Administration Circular No. 15/90 by the Commissioner of Examination under the supervisor of the Board of Sri Lanka Technological Service. The date of conducting the examination, place and time will be notified in due course.

2. *Method of Application.*— The application should be on the specimen form appended to this notification and should be preferred by the candidate himself on A-4 paper using both side of the paper. It should be specially notice that the application form should be so prepared that Nos. 1-8 appear on the first page and No. 09 onwards appear on the rest of the pages.

(i) The candidates who are in the Public/Corporation/ Provincial Public Service should submit their applications through the Head of the Dept. under whom they serve. The Head of Dept. should certify that the particulars given in the application are true and correct and that he could be released from service.

(ii) The complete application should be sent by registered post to the General Manager of Railway, so as to reach him on or before 11.03.2005. The top left hand corner of the envelope containing the application should bear clear the words "Application for Recruitment to the Guard Training Grade". Application should be complete in all respects.

(iii) Any application which do not conform to the *Gazette* Notification and late application will be rejected without prior notice allegations that any application has been lost or delayed in the post will not be considered.
