1. *Post.*— Medical Officer (Homoeopathy).

2. *Age Limit.*— Not less than 25 years and not more than 40 years. Upper age limit will not apply to those who are in the Public Service.

3. *Educational and other Qualifications :*

- (i) Posses a Degree/Diploma in Homoeopathy Medical Science after following a course in Homoeopathic Medical Science for a period of not less than 4 years at a Homoeopathy Institution in India, Pakistan or any other European Country where Homoeopathy is implemented through a branch of state health services which is recognized by the Government of Sri Lanka ;
- (ii) Should have obtained not less than 6 months Homoeopathy Internship ; and
- (iii) Should have obtained registration as a Homoeopathic Practitioner in the Country where the Diploma/Degree was

obtained and should be a Homoeopathic Practitioner registered at the Homoeopathic Council in Sri Lanka ; and

- (iv) Should have professional experience at least for one year after registration as a Homoeopathic Practitioner.

Note.— Preference will be given to those applicants who have at least one year professional training after gaining registration as Homoeopathic Practitioner.

4. *Salary Scale.*— T. A. 10-1-1 Rs. 123,300 -1-2,700 - Rs. 12,600. They will be placed on the salary step of Rs. 123,300 per annum.

5. *Terms of Engagement.*— Recruitment will be made for the post on contract basis.

Appointment to posts of Inquirer (into Sudden Deaths) under Section 108 of the Code of Criminal Procedure Act, No.15 of 1979

APPLICATIONS are called for the vacant posts of Inquirer (into Sudden Deaths) in the areas indicated in the schedule hereto.

02. Applications prepared according to the specimen below should be sent under registered cover to reach the Secretary, Ministry of Justice, Law Reform and National Integration on or before 29.04.2005. The envelope containing the application should be marked "Post of Inquirer (into Sudden Deaths) District" on its top left hand corner. Late applications will be rejected without any notice whatsoever.

03. The post is not a permanent post in Government Service. The appointment will be given to be valid upto the age of 60 years and will be extended accordingly up to the age of 76 years an obtaining relevant recommendations and medical certificates, The Minister may remove an Inquirer (into Sudden Deaths) at any time prior to that date for causes assigned. The appointment will be in respect of an area specified in the schedule hereto.

04. Appointees will be required to carry out the functions of an Inquirer (into Sudden Deaths) as set out in the Code of Criminal Procedure Act, No. 15 of 1979.

05. The post does not carry a salary. However, a fee of Rs.300 per inquiry and travelling and subsistence allowance will be paid.

06. Only persons possessing the following qualifications are eligible to apply :

- (a) Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka
- (b) Should have been a permanent resident in the area to which appointment is sought, for the past two years.
- (c) Should be not less than 30 years and not more than 58 years of age on the closing date of applications.
- (d) Should have passed G. C. E. (O/L) examination or an equivalent examination with 04 credits in not less than 05 subjects including the two subject of Sinhala/Tamil Language and arithmetic/mathematics/Commercial arithmetic in one sitting and completing 06 subjects in two sittings.

Note.— When these qualifications are reckoned an ordinary pass obtained at the G. C. E. (A/L) examination will be considered as a credit pass for that subject at the G.C. E. (O/L) examination.

- (e) Should be of excellent moral character and physically sound. Preference will be given to persons who abstain from consuming liquor and from smoking.

07. Persons who on the closing date of applications are in receipt of a salary or an allowance from the government, a Provincial Council Fund or a fund of a Local Government Institution, or employees and

members of Boards of Directors of Government Corporations and Co-operative Societies, Members of Provincial Councils, and members of Local Government institutions are not eligible to apply for this post.

08. No documents should be attached to the application. However, applicants should produce adequate evidence in proof of all the qualifications at the interview and should produce the originals of the following certificates.

- (a) Birth Certificate;
- (b) Educational Certificates ;
- (c) National Identity Card ;
- (d) Grama Niladhari's Certificate in proof of permanent residence;
- (e) Two recent Certificates of Character;
- (f) Other Certificates, if any, in support of additional qualifications;
- (g) In case of retired officers, documentary evidence in support of the date of retirement;

09. All applications should be completed in legible writing in compliance with the specimen set out below. Applications which do not contain all the information required to be furnished will be rejected without any notice.

10. In filling the specimen application, special care should be taken to indicate accurate details of eligibility criteria. Appointments of candidates, who fall into the category of persons stipulated in para 07 or who provide false information for paras 6 or 7 above will be cancelled forthwith if the actual position in discovered after appointment subsequent to selection at the interview.

11. If a person appointed as a Inquirer (into Sudden Deaths) is subsequently appointed to a post stipulated in para 7 above, his appointment to the post of Inquirer will terminate with effect from the date of such subsequent appointment.
