VACANCIES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AYURVEDA

APPLICATIONS are invited from qualified citizens of Sri Lanka for filling of following vacancies existing in the Drug Research and Quality Assurance Laboratory and Botany Division in the Bandaranayake Memorial Ayurveda Research Institute of the Department of Ayurveda, Nawinna.

Age limit.— Candidates should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

The minimum age limit for the Post of Scientific Officer is 28 years.

Service Conditions :

- (i) Recruitments to this post will be made purely on contract basis and the period of the service of such posts will be

subjected to one year. The extensions of the service will be considered on yearly basis depending on the service requirement and efficiency/ the satisfactory condition of the service.

- (ii) All officers recruited are required to make contributions to the Public Services Provident Fund.
- (iii) Any revision of the salary will not be made during the first 03 years in the contract service.
- (iv) Allowances granted to other officers in Public Service from time to time, by the Government are not applicable for this post.
- (v) These posts will be subjected to the provisions laid down in the Establishments Code, other revisions made to it from time to time and any other rules and regulations applied in respect of public servants.

Open Competitive Examination—2005 for Recruitment to the Post of Agricultural Instructors to Segment “B”, Class II of the Sri Lanka Technical Service to the Department of Agriculture

APPLICATIONS are invited from the citizens of Sri Lanka for the Open Competitive Examination for recruitment to the Post of Agricultural Instructors to Segment “B”, Class II of the Sri Lanka Technical Service to the Department of Agriculture. The applications prepared as per specimen appended at the end of the notification on 21.5cm. x 30cm. (8 1/2" x 12") size paper using both sides should be completed and sent only under Registered cover to reach the Director General of Agriculture, the Department of Agriculture, Peradeniya on or before 15.02.2005. “Post of Agricultural Instructor” should be marked on the top left corner of the envelope enclosing the application and along with the application a self - addressed stamped envelope of 9"x 4" size should be sent to post the Admission Card under Registered cover. Officers already in the Public Service or the Provincial Public Service should send their applications through the Head of the Department/Chief Secretary/Secretary to the Provincial Ministry.

N.B. :

The candidates should have fulfilled all the qualifications stipulated in the *Gazette* Notification by the closing date of applications. Any application not in accordance with the specimen appended to the Notification, not duly completed and not in order is liable to be rejected without any notice. Applications should not be addressed personally to officials of the Department and such applications sent by post or handed over will not be entertained. No complaint that an application has been lost or delayed in the post will be considered.

02. A notice will be published in the newspapers as soon as admission cards are issued to candidates.
