The ancient monuments specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected monument for the purposes of the Antiquities ordinance.

1. The Ketavala ancient ambalama (pedestrians' resting hall) situated in the Village of Uva Ketavala in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Haliela of the Badulla District, Uva Province.
2. The Atampitiya ancient ambalama (pedestrians' resting hall) situated in the Village of Atampitiya in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Haliela of the Badulla District, Uva Province.

3. The Fort of Alupota situated in the Village of Alupota in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Badalkumbura of the Moneragala District, Uva Province.
4. The archaeological of Weerasekaragama situated in the Village of Wellavaya Varuna in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Wellavaya of the Moneragala District, Uva Province.
5. The ancient building of Weheragodella situated in the Grama Niladari Division 115/G, Neluvagolla in the Divisional Secretary's Division of Wellavaya of the Moneragala District, Uva Province.
