Admission of Apprentices – 2005

APPLICATIONS are invited from Sri Lankan Citizens (Male/Female) possessing the minimum qualifications stipulated in para. 02 herein for admission of apprentices to the Sri Lanka - German Technical Training Center for the year, 2005.

02. Minimum Qualifications :

- (a) *Age Limit.*— Should be between 16 - 25 years as at 31.05.2005.
- (b) *Educational Qualifications.*— Should have passed the General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination in 06 Subjects inclusive of Sinhala/Tamil Language, Mathematics and Science in not more than two sittings. It is required to possess educational qualifications completely before 31.12.2004 and passing of 05 subjects in first sitting.

03. *Training Course.*— The apprentices selected for training will be given an opportunity to follow a course for the following profession subject to the period specified against each course. The Course will be conducted only in Sinhala Medium. 18 Persons each for the following courses will be selected.

04. *Applications.*— Applicants should indicate their particulars correctly in the application forms prepared in a white blank sheet of 297m.m. in length and 210m.m. in width (A4) according to the specimen attached herewith, incomplete applications will be rejected.

05. Selection for the Course

- (1) Selections will be made on the results of a written test and an interview only the applicant who possess the minimum qualifications stipulated and who have paid the Examination fees specified in para. 07 will be summoned for the interview.
- (2) Written examination will be conducted on the basis of General knowledge and basic technical knowledge and mathematics. The candidates who score the highest marks at the written tests will be called for the interview/practical test on the basis of each course.
- (3) The candidates who score the highest aggregate marks at the written and practical tests will be selected for each course.

06. *Medium of Examination.*— Medium of Examination will be Sinhala, Tamil and English.

07. *Examination Fees.*— A non - refundable fee of Rs. 150 will be charged for the examination. This amount can be paid by Money Order written in favour of the General Manager of Railways indicating paying-in-office as Maradana Post Office or to any Railway Station or to the Railway Chief Accountants' Office and the receipt or the Money Order should be attached to the application. Applications of candidates who fail to attach receipts or Money Order will be rejected. It should be noted that examination fees will not be refunded for failure to appear before the examination or any other reason.

08. *Examination Center.*— A written examination will be conducted only in Colombo in respect of candidates who fulfill all the requirements.

09. *Signing of Agreement.*— All applicants selected for training in the Institution should sign an Agreement with the National Apprentice and Technical Training Authority.

10. The Apprentice will be paid a monthly allowance during the Period of Training by the National Apprentice and Technical Training Authority.

11. The Department is not bound to give employment to the apprentices after the training.

12. The application form prepared in accordance with the specimen form given below should be sent to the Director Sri Lanka - German Railway Technical Training Center, Ratmalana by registered post, "SLG RTT/2005" should be indicated on top left hand corner of the envelope.

13. *Closing date of applications.*— Applications will be entertained up to 25.08.2005 and late applications will be rejected.

Competitive Examination for recruitment to the Post of Trainee Assistant Superintendent of Stores

APPLICATIONS are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka who are not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age as at 22.08.2005 to fill 01 vacancy in the post of Trainee Assistant Superintendent of Stores of the Department of Railways. The closing date of applications is 22.08.2005. The applications should be sent under registered cover to reach to General Manager of Railways, Department of Railways, Colombo 10, before the closing date. Applications addressed personally to any officer of the Department or delivered by hand will not be entertained. Incomplete informal and late applications, and which are not in conformity with the stipulated qualifications will be rejected without prior notice. Applicants who are in Public Service or Provincial Public Service should forward their applications through the Heads of their respective Institutions, before the stipulated date.

01. *Salary Scale*. - Rs. 147,180-16-3480-Rs. 203,860 (As. per P. A. Circular No. 9/2004 TB 3-8-2) (Should pass the Efficiency Bar Examination within 03 years of the appointment)

02. *Educational Qualifications/Alternative qualifications*. - Should possess a First Class or Second Class Honours Degree from a recognized University.

or

An officer with at least 05 years service in the grade of Time Recording Clerk, Station Master, Railway Guard, Railway Clerk or in clerical or parallel service, who holds a degree from a recognized University or Four Year National Higher Diploma in Accountancy at the Sri Lanka Technical College.

or

03. Years experience as an executive in a recognized institute with Associate Membership of the Sri Lanka Supplies and Materials Management Institute.

Note.- Should have an ability to work in English

03. *Method of Recruitment.-* Recruitment will be on merit performed at a written competitive examination. The required number of candidates who have scored the highest aggregate of marks at the written examination will be called up for an Interview Board appointed by the Public Service Commission, and selection will be made on its recommendation. Marks will not be assigned at the interview.

04. *Scheme of Examination*

- (a) The examination will be conducted by the Commissioner General of Examinations or other Govt. Institute.
- (b) There will be two Question Papers.
- (c) Maximum marks for each paper will be 100 Candidates should obtain 50% of marks or more in each subject to qualify.

05. *Syllabus*

- (a) Comprehension and knowledge of English (Total marks 100)
 - Part I - Comprehension (50 marks)
 - Questions will be raised on International and local economic Political social and cultural fields
 - Part II - Knowledge of English (50 marks)

A paper to assess the knowledge in English. Questions will include on ability to translate grammatical usage of English language correspondence with inter - institutes, comprehension, summarizing and preparation of reports.

- (b) Intelligence test (Marks 100)

It is designed to test the candidates ability to thinking in logical terms, analytical thinking and decision making. The question paper is of multiple choice.

06. *Terms of Engagement .-* The post is temporary. Contributions should be made towards the Public Service Provident Fund. If an officer holding a permanent and pensionable post in Govt. Service is selected, he could continue to contribute towards the Widows Orphans,/Widowers, Orphans, Pension Scheme.

07. *Conditions of Service .-* Sections 10 and 12 of Chapter II of the Establishment Code will apply.

- (a) Candidates selected for appointment as Trainee Assistant Railway Stores Superintendent will be required to follow a 3 year training course as decided upon by the General Manager of Railways. During the said period of training they should acquire a thorough knowledge in Accounts and general working of a Store, warehouses, and Stores Office.
- (b) Appointment to the permanent and pensionable post of Assistant Railway Stores Supdt. after successful completion of the training period and on passing the tests will depend on the availability of vacancies. When there are no vacancies in the grade of Assistant Railway Stores Superintendent, he will be appointed as Super - numerary Asst. Railway Supdt. until such time the vacancies occur.
