**1. Qualifications :**

- (vi) Has other qualifications acceptable to the Sri Lanka Technical Services Council as equivalent to the Technical qualifications stated above.

*Note.*—Those who have obtained a diploma of the Open University may be exempted from the requirement of passing G.C.E. (O/L) provided that they have passed the basic course applicable to such diploma.

**3. Method of Recruitment.**—Applications will be invited through an advertisement in the *Government Gazette* or through a notice published in leading newspapers and recruitment will be made on the basis of merit at competitive examination held in terms of P.A. Circular No. 15/90. The syllabus for the examination and the scheme of selection are set out below :
