Sri Lanka Technical Service, Class II 'B'

APPLICATIONS are invited for the Post of Laboratory Assistant, Class II 'B' of the Sri Lanka Technical Service at the Government Analyst's Department.

(02) Applications prepared according to the specimen attached hereto should be sent under registered cover to reach the Government Analyst, Government Analyst's Department, Independence Square, Colombo 7, before 22.08.2005.

The words "Post of Laboratory Assistant", should be written on the top left hand corner of the envelope.

Applications received after the above date will not be accepted.

(03) Salary Scale :

According to Public Administration Circular No. 9/2004 dated 27.12.2004 ; Training Grade. — Rs. 103,200-1x1,320-Rs.104,520.

The annual consolidated salary scale for Laboratory Assistant II B is, Rs. 105,840-7x1,320-10x1,560-130,680 (An Efficiency Bar will operate before the third annual salary step).

(04) Educational and other Qualifications:

- (a) Applicant should be a citizen of Sri Lanka ;
- (b) Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age as at 22.08.2005 ;
(the upper age limit will not apply to officers who are already in public service or provincial public service) .
- (c) Should be of good character ;
- (d) (i) External candidates (90%)

- (1) G.C.E. (Advanced Level) Examination in Three (3) subjects including the subject of Chemistry relevant to the service, should be from among the subjects of Pure Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Combined Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Botany, Biology and Agriculture;

and

- (2) G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in Six (6) subjects with credit passes for Language or Literature, Mathematics, Science and one other subject in not more than two sittings.

(2) Internal candidates (10%)

Employees of the Department who have 10 years experience in the relevant field with G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in Six (06) subjects with credit passes for Language or Literature, Mathematics, Science and one other subject in not more than two sittings, will be appointed on the basis of the results of a Departmental Examination. Selection will be made from among those who have completed a Minimum of 05 years of satisfactory service in Class I of the Post of Laboratory Sub-assistant.

(05) Method of Recruitment:

Recruitment will be made under the supervision of the Technical Services Board subject to the provisions of the Establishments Code.

(06) Terms of Employment:

This post is permanent. The selected candidates are required to contribute to the Contributory Pensions Fund. The pension scheme will operate in respect of persons who are already in pensionable posts.

(07) Conditions of Service.—

- (1) The period of training is 02 years ;
- (2) The probation period is 03 years ;
- (3) Sections 10-12 of Chapter II of the Establishments Code will apply.

(08) Applications are required to submit copies of the following certificates along with their applications.

- (1) Highest educational and technical certificates ;
- (2) Certificate of Registration of Birth issued by the Registrar General ;
- (3) Three recent certificate of character (Two of which should be from the Principle of the school last attended and the Grama Niladhari of the area where the candidate is resident).
