Vacancies in Class II Grade II of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service

APPLICATIONS are invited from citizens of Sri Lanka with necessary qualifications to be appointed to the vacancies of Veterinary Research Officer, Veterinary Surgeon and Livestock Officer in Class II Grade II of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service. Applications prepared according to the specimen form attached to this notice on a A4 Size 8 1/2" x 12" paper using both sides should be sent under registered cover to reach the "Director General, Department of Animal Production and Health, No. 1120, Getambe, Peradeniya" on or before 01.04.2005.

- Note :** (i) Appointments for the post of Veterinary Research Officer and Veterinary Surgeon will be made only from open recruitments. 50% of the vacancies of the post of Livestock Officer will be filled through open recruitments. In the event there are not enough candidates qualifying from the limited recruitment to fill the vacancies equivalent to the percentage allowed for the limited recruitment under para 10 (i) of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service Minute for the post of Livestock Officer, the balance of the vacancies will be filled from the open recruitment.
- (ii) A candidate with the required qualifications can make separate applications for any number of posts from among the post of Veterinary Research Officer, Veterinary Surgeon, and Livestock Officer.
- (iii) Complaints about the loss or a delay in the post of an application or of a related letter to such an application will not be considered. The loss to the candidate by delaying the application till the last date will have to borne by the candidates themselves. "Post of Veterinary Research Officer/Veterinary Surgeon/Livestock Officer in Class II Grade II of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service" should be written on the top left hand corner of the envelope containing the application.
- (iv) The applications of the candidates who have not fulfilled the basic requirements will be rejected.

2. Terms of employment and conditions of service :

- (i) The posts are permanent. You are entitled for a contributory pension under the contributory pension fund. The appointments are subjected to a 3 year probationary period.
- (ii) The selected candidates will be appointed to fill a Scheduled post in the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service for which they apply.

- (iii) Other terms of employment and conditions of service will be as laid down in the Regulations of the Minutes of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service published in Para I - Part I of the *Gazette* of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka dated 31.10.1980 and its amendments, provisions laid down in the Establishment Code and the Orders of the Public Administration Circulars issued from time to time.

3. Salary Scale.—

The consolidated salary scale of Class II Grade II of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service is Rs. 112,500 - 15 x 2,700 - 153,000 per annum. An officer appointed to Class II Grade II of the Sri Lanka Animal Production and Health Service should pass the first efficiency bar examination before reaching the salary point of Rs. 120, 600 per annum and the second efficiency bar examination before reaching the salary point of Rs. 128,700 per annum.

- Note : (i) Persons at the time of recruitment to class II grade II, having recognized post graduate qualifications at MA/MSc or higher level, in addition to the prescribed basic qualifications, will be placed at the 4th Step of the salary scale with an annual salary not exceeding Rs. 123,300.
- (ii) The selected candidates should either obtain a recognized post graduate qualification or should pass the second efficiency bar examination for promoting over the second efficiency bar.

4. General requirements for the recruitments.—

- (a) All candidates must be citizens of Sri Lanka.
- (b) Should be not less than 20 years and not more than 35 years of age at the closing date of the applications.
- (c) In the case of the applicants with post graduate qualifications, the upper age limit is 40 years.
- (d) Should be of excellent moral character and of good health. The physical fitness should be confirmed with a medical examination report.
- (e) The veterinary graduates must have the registration from the Sri Lanka Veterinary Council
- (f) The upper age limit prescribed will not apply to those made under limited recruitments.

5. Open Recruitment Educational Qualifications.—

- (i) Veterinary Research Officers :

A four year degree in Veterinary Science from a recognized University with a 1st or 2nd Class Upper Division pass.

- (ii) Veterinary Surgeons :

A four year degree in Veterinary Science from a recognized University.

- (iii) Livestock Officers :

A four year degree in Veterinary Science/Animal Husbandry/Agriculture from a recognized University.

- Note :- (i) Applicants must fulfill the requirements of the degree, prescribed as the basic educational qualification for the post applied, on or before the last date for the closing of applications. The date of conferment of the degree should be a date on or before the last date of the closing of applications.
- (ii) Applications made based on pending degree results are not considered valid.

6. Method of recruitment.—

- (a) Appointments for the post of Veterinary Research Officer and Veterinary Surgeon will be made only from open recruitments. 50% of the vacancies of the post of Livestock Officer will be filled through open recruitments. In the event there are not enough candidates qualifying from the limited recruitment to fill the vacancies equivalent to the percentage allowed for the limited recruitment for the post of Livestock Officer, the balance of the vacancies will be filled from the open recruitment.
- (b) A candidate with the required qualifications can make separate applications for any number of posts from among the post of Veterinary Research Officer, Veterinary Surgeon, and Livestock Officer.
- (c) Candidates obtaining 50% or more marks for each prescribed question paper conducted by the Commissioner General of Examinations will be called for an interview after considering the aggregate of the marks obtained for the subject specific paper and the general paper
