APPLICATIONS are invited from the citizens of Sri Lanka, possessing the following qualifications to appoint for the post in Class III Grade II of the Sri Lanka Surveyors' Service. All the applications prepared in accordance with the specimen given below should be sent in registered post to reach the surveyor General, No. 15, Kirula Road, Narahenpita, Colombo 05 on or before 2005.04.08 the wordings "Application for the Post in S.L.S.S. III/II" should be mentioned in the top left hand corner of the envelope carrying the application form. Applications sent through other sources outside the post, will be rejected.

02. All the applicants should certify that they have fulfilled the following eligibility requirements.

- (i) Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka ;
- (ii) Should be not less than 21 years and not more than 35 years of age as at the closing date of the application ;
(Maximum age limit does not apply to those already in public service)
- (iii) Should be of excellent character and physically fit.

03. Conditions of Service :

- (i) This post is permanent. the employees are entitled to the contributory pensions scheme as per Management Circular No. 18, and should contribute 8% of their monthly salary to the Contributory Fund.
- (ii) The selected candidates will be appointed to the Class III Grade II of the Sri Lanka Surveyors' service subjected to the General conditions governing the appointments of the Public Service, conditions stipulated in the Surveyors' service minute published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 651/8 and dated 27.02.1991 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, and the amendments made and will be made to the said Minute in future.

04. Conditions of Appointment :

- (i) The Selected applicants should undergo training for a period of 03 (three) years, consisting of a period of not less than a 02 (two) years of training at Institute of Surveying and Mapping and the balance period will include a practical training. This period of training will also be counted as the probation period.

- (ii) Those who get through the Diploma in Survey Technician (Advance Level) Examination, after successful completion of the said training period, will be confirmed in the service.
- (iii) The probationary period of officers who are unable to pass the Examination stipulated in paragraph II above will be extended to a period of 05 (five) years from the date of appointment. The services of the officers who are unable to fulfill the said qualification within the said period will be terminated.
- (iii) Provisions stipulated in I and II above, will not be applicable for Surveying Science graduates and they will be appointed subject to a probationary period of three years.
- (iv) Surveying Science Graduates will be given a three months Management Training after their recruitment.

05. Salary Scale :

06. *Educational Qualifications* :- should obtain a degree in following areas from a recognized University.

- I. A Degree in surveying ;
- II. A Degree in Applied Mathematics or Pure Mathematics ;
- III. A Degree in Engineering ;
- IV. A Degree in Physics with mathematics as an auxiliary subject at degree level ;
- V. A Degree in Geography with Mathematics as an auxiliary subject at degree level.

07. Method of Selection :

Selections will be made on the results of the interview. Priority of the marks obtained at the interview will be the basis for selection. Special preferences will be given to those who have obtained a Degree in surveying Science from a recognized University.

08. The applications received after the closing date and those without the required qualifications and which are not duly perfected will be rejected.

09. If any candidate is found to be disqualified he/she is liable to the cancellation of his/her candidacy before the interview or at the interview or after in any instance.

10. Those already in Government Service should forward their applications through their Head of Departments. This Office will not be responsible for applications lost in post.

applications will be rejected and no applications will be issued by
the Sri Lanka Police Department.

03. *Salary Scale.*— Police Constable Driver. The salary scale attached to this post is -

In addition to the above salary scale they will be paid following monthly allowances.

(a) *Special Arduous Duty Allowances :*

04. *Basic qualifications.*—

(a) *Age limit.*— The age should be between 19 and 26 years as at closing date of application as per the *Gazette* Notification.

(b) *Educational qualifications.*— Should have passed 6 subjects at one sitting including Mathematics and medium language at the G.C.E. O/L examination.

Note 01.— According to the classification of subjects of the Department of Examinations in calculating the numbers of subjects passed at G.C.E. (O/L) both passes in Science subjects numbers 41 and 44 will be treated as one subjects and both the passes in Mathematics numbers 42 and 45 will be treated as one subjects. the number of subjects passed at the G.C.E. (O/L) examination will be decided accordingly.

Note 02.— Failure in the technical subject at written test of G.C.E. (O/L) examination will be considered as failure in the same subject, although a pass has been obtained for the same in the practical test.

Note 03.— Since optional subjects of Tamil, English and Sinhala have not been included in the stream of G.C.E. (O/L) passes in any of these subjects will not be reckoned as a pass in the G.C.E. (O/L) examination.

(c) *Physical Requirements.*—

- (i) Height 5 feet 3 inches.
- (ii) Chest 30 inches (deflated)

Note.— Applicants who are short of required height and chest respectively by 1/2 inch and 01 inch and fulfill the other stipulated qualifications will be eligible at the discretion of Inspector General of Police provided they have skills in sports or achieved best performance in sports at National level or they have earned reputation for Sri Lanka by participating in an International competition.

(d) *Visual requirements.*— Vision should not be less than 6/12 with each eye. If the vision is 6/6 with one eye and 6/18 with the other eye it will also be accepted. Colour vision should be normal. Applicants wearing spectacles or contact lenses will not be eligible.

(e) *Trade qualifications.*—

- (i) Certificate of competence in driving light or heavy vehicles.
- (ii) Atleast, one year experience in driving motor vehicles after obtaining the above certificate.

Note.— Priority will be given in case of knowledge of Motor Mechanism, experience in repairs to vehicles and long experience in driving vehicles.

(f) *Other qualifications.*—

(i) Applicants should be unmarried (those who are divorced shall be treated as married). These conditions are not applicable to the officers who are already in the service as Reserve Police Constable Drivers and who have satisfied other qualifications.

(ii) If any applicant has deformity or any other physical disability which impedes movement of physical limb required for competence in driving will be disqualified, although he has obtained a medical certificate to the effect that he is fit for the service.

(iii) the applicants who have basic qualifications will be tested for their ability to drive and maintain vehicles. Their knowledge of road rules and traffic signals and basic knowledge of mechanical theories of the vehicle in which the applicant has achieved competence in driving will also be tested.

(iv) Selected applicants will be required to pass a medical examination prior to enlistment. Those who are found medically unfit for service in the Police will be rejected.

(v) Applicants must qualify in an endurance test and a trade test which will be held by the Police Department prior to their appearance before the final selection board.

The following areas will be tested in the trade test.

- (a) Competence in driving vehicles.
- (b) The Highway code.
- (c) Knowledge of maintenance of, and minor repairs to vehicles.

05. *Terms of Engagement :*

- (i) The post is permanent, appointees are entitled to contributory pension under the contributory pension fund.
- (ii) 8% of the monthly earnings should be paid to the contributory pension Fund from the date of enlistment.

- (iii) All the officers will be required to contribute to departmental funds.

06. *Conditions of Service :*

- (a) The appointments will be on probation for a period of 3 years.
- (b) The selected applicants will be required to comply with any rules already made or may hereafter be made to give effect to the language policy of the Government.
- (c) they will be subject to the relevant provisions of the Establishments Code Volume I and II, the Financial Regulations, the Departmental orders and to any other orders that may be issued by the Inspector General of Police or by the government from time to time.
- (d) Before confirmation, every officer will be required to pass the prescribed departmental tests. Those who fail to pass the prescribed test or are found to be unfit for police duties will be liable for removal from the police service.
- (e) Selected applicants will not be allowed to marry until they have been confirmed in their appointments other than with the express permission of the Inspector General of Police under exceptional compelling reasons after a minimum period of two years satisfactory service in terms of Police Gazette part II No. 41 of 28th February, 1973.
- (f) The appointees after completion of their training period, should serve a probationary period of 3 years in the police Department. If they wish to resign from the posts before completion of the period of probationary period they should sign an agreement at the time of handing over the letter of resignation giving their consent to refund the expenses incurred in training, and uniform together with any other payments prescribed. The amount to be paid will be calculated and determined by the Director, Sri Lanka Police College. the acceptance. The acceptance of resignation should be in accordance with section 4 Chapter V of the Establishments Code, Volume I published in the year 1985.

- (g) Recruit Police Constable Drivers should subscribe affirmation/oath to the effect that they comply with police Code of conduct in terms of I.G.P.'s Circular No. 1693/2003 immediately after commencement of training in the Police College.

(h) Recruit Police Constable Drivers should subscribe affirmation/oath to the effect that they comply with the oath of allegiance to the Public Service in terms of the I.G.P.'s Circular No. 1804/2004 immediately after commencement of training in the Police College.

- (i) Police Constable Drivers who have been confirmed will be entitled to promotions in accordance with the approved scheme of promotion in the Police Department.

07. (a) Attention is invited to the general conditions applicable to appointments to posts in the State Service Published in the Section II (A) of the Part I of this *Gazette*.

(b) Enlistment will be made in terms of Public Administration Circular No. 15/90 dated 10.03.1990.
