FOREIGN LIQUOR TAVERN RENT SALE IN BATTICALOA DISTRICT - 2006

TENDERS for the purchase of the exclusive privilege of selling Foreign Liquor under a Tavern License at the under-mentioned locality for period of January 01st 2006 to December 31st, 2006 subject to the General Conditions for the time being in force and the Foreign Liquor Sales Condition 1982 published in the *Gazette of the Republic of Sri Lanka* No. 207 of 20.08.1982 will be received by the Government Agent, Batticaloa District at the Batticaloa Kachcheri up to the date and time specified below. Tenderer should be present at the Kachcheri at the time of opening of Tenders.

2. Tenders are to be made on forms obtained at any Kachcheri at the office of the Excise Commissioner, Colombo, Assistant Commissioner of Excise, Kandy or Superintendent of Excise, Batticaloa on producing of Kachcheri receipt for Rs. 1,500 in respect of each tender form. The Kachcheri receipt should be attached to the tender form. The issue of tender forms will close at 12.00 noon on 26.10.2005.

3. Tenderer should attach to every tender a certificate of worth as required by Foreign Tavern Rent sale conditions published in the *Gazette of the Republic of Sri Lanka* No. 207 of 20.08.1982.

4. Tender forms perfected incorrectly will be rejected.

5. Refunds of tender deposits to those who have not submitted their tenders will be considered if requests for such refunds are made to me within two weeks of closing the tender along with blank tender documents.

6. The successful tenderer on being declared the purchaser, shall pay immediately to the Government Agent, Batticaloa District Security Deposit such sum as may be fixed by him and sign the conditions and contract furnishing necessary stamp. Refunds of tender deposit for unsuccessful tenderers will be considered only after the agreement is signed by the successful tenderer.

7. The successful tenderer should change the place where the tavern was situated to a suitable place (i.e. within ward No. 01, Batticaloa Municipal Council).

8. There is no guarantee that the existing tavern sites will be available for the ensuring period.

SALE OF FOREIGN LIQUOR TAVERN RENTS FOR THE YEAR 2006— COLOMBO DIVISIONAL SECRETARIAT DIVISION

TENDERS are hereby invited for the purchase of the exclusive privilege of selling foreign liquor (including locally made malt liquor) under a tavern licence from 01st January, 2006 to 31st December, 2006 in suitable premises within the respective under-mentioned local area, approved by the Government subject to —

- (i) the Foreign Liquor Tavern Rent Sale Conditions appearing in *Gazette* of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka No. 207 of 20.08.1982;
- (ii) the General Conditions for the time being in force and applicable to all Excise Licences.

2. Every tender must be made on the prescribed form which may be obtained at the Colombo Divisional Secretariat Office and must be accompanied by a Divisional Secretariat receipt acknowledging the deposit of the sum specified below against each tavern at column (f) and a worth certificate obtained from the Divisional Secretary. Worth Certificate hold good for a period of five years from the date of issue, if there has been no disposal of any of the properties included in the Schedule whereon such certificates of worth were based. When the validity of a worth certificate lapses before the end of the rental year the tenderes should either submit along with the tender a fresh certificate to cover the full rental period or submit an additional certificate for the balance period at least one month before the validity of the old certificate expires.

3. Every tender must be placed in a sealed envelope, clearly marked on top left-hand corner “Tender for Foreign Liquor Tavern No.....Colombo Divisional Secretariat Division 2006” and must reach the Colombo Divisional Secretary, on the dates and times as shown below against each Tavern.

Tenderers should be present at the Divisional Secretariat at the time of closing of Tenders.

4. The successful tenderer shall immediately on being informed that he is the purchaser of the privilege, sign the Conditions of Sale and pay to the Divisional Secretary as security deposit a sum as specified for the privilege in terms of the Foreign Liquor Rent Sale Conditions referred to above.

5. If any tenderer on being declared the purchaser of the privilege, declines, to sign the Agreement relating to the Conditions of Sale or fails to furnish the required security when called upon to do so, the tender deposit made by him, will be declare to be forfeited and the defaulter will render himself liable to have his name entered in the list of defaulters in respect of all Excise Licences. Subject to the aforesaid Conditions the tender deposits of tenderers will be refunded after the full security has been furnished and the Agreement relating to the Conditions of Sale has been signed by the Successful tenderer.

6. The Divisional Secretary reserves to himself the right of rejecting any or all tenders without assigning any reason for so doing.

7. There is no guarantee that the existing Foreign Liquor Tavern sites will be available for the rent year 2005. Successful tenderers should find suitable buildings within the respective divisions and the approval of the Commissioner of Excise should be obtained for such building. The responsibility to provide buildings does not rest with the Divisional Secretary.
