- (iii) A certificate from National Apprenticeship Board to the effect that applicant has successfully completed a two year professional course on the vocation or the trade the applicant is due to be appointed.

The applications should include a receipt to the value of Rs. 100 credited to SLIATE Account No. 0025-1010129111 at People's Bank, Park Street Branch or any other Branch of People's Bank in Sri Lanka and a self-addressed stamped envelope. The course applied for should be clearly stated on the top left-hand corner of the envelope. The applications should be sent to the relevant Institute.

A candidate who wishes to apply for more than one Institute should submit separate application for each Institute attaching the required payment. Applications which do not meet the above requirements will be rejected.

The applications received after the closing date will not be entertained.

The addresses of the Advanced Technical Institutes/ATI Sections with the courses conducted by each is given in Section 'A' and the Applicant should select their courses only from list given in section 'B' suiting to their qualifications.
