**LEASE OF "KELANIYA INN" OWNED BY THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND HOME AFFAIRS TO THE PRIVATE MANAGEMENT**

TENDERS are initiated by the Chairman, Tender Board of the Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs for the lease of "Kelaniya Inn" to Private Management for a period of five years from individuals/institutions fulfilling the following requirements ;

- (a) Minimum of 5 years experience in food supply or hotel management ;
- (b) The business has been registered by the owner in his name under the Business Names Ordinance or a Company registered under the Company Act, No. 17 of 1982 or a partnership registered under the Partnership Act of 1890.
- (c) Sufficient financial stability to conduct business activities ;
- (d) Ability to deposit rental for (6) six months in cash before signing the lease agreements.

All the tenders should be submitted on the tender forms obtained from this Ministry on a payment of Rs. 5,000 as tender fee. Tender documents can be obtained from the Senior Assistant Secretary (D.A) on the 8th floor of this Ministry during working days from 10.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. up to 18.11.2005.

A refundable tender fee of Rs. 50,000 should be deposited as security by the tenderers and this amount can be deposited either in cash or by way of a bank guarantee. The receipt issued on payment of money or the bank guarantee should be attached to the tender documents.

- (e) Has not been convicted by a Court of Law three years prior to the submission of tenders.

2. If tenders have been submitted by any person/institutions without fulfilling the requirements referred to in Para. 4(a) to (d) above, such tenders will be rejected. Further incomplete tenders will be rejected.

3. The successful tenderer will be informed by registered post that his tender has been accepted and within 7 days of receipt of such notice, he should enter into an agreement with the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs regarding the lease of the Inn. Before entering into the agreement, a security deposit equal to 6 months rental should be deposited in cash with the Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs.

4. The Secretary to the Ministry has the authority to terminate the contract for the reasons given below although the period of contract is 5 years as per the agreement :

- (a) Unauthorized use of Inn or part thereof ;
- (b) Failure to maintain services of the Inn satisfactorily ;
- (c) Failure to make proper payment of monthly rentals ;
- (d) Failure to pay rentals for two consecutive months.

5. Either of two parties has the right to cancel the contract giving three months notice during the period of contract and with the lapse of three months of giving such notice, contract ceases to be valid.

6. Duly completed Tender Forms (in duplicate) should be sent in a sealed envelope and should be addressed to Chairman Tender Board, Ministry of Public Administration and Home Affairs to reach him before 2 p.m. on 18.11.2005 on the left hand corner of the envelope "Tender for the Lease of Kelaniya Inn to Private Management" should be marked. The tenders may be—
