05. No person is permitted to send in more than one tender for any one tavern and not more than persons any jointly tender for any one tavern.

06. The amount of tender should be given both in words and in figures and every alternation in the tender should be authenticated with the full signature of the tenderer and dated. Every tender should signed by two witnesses. Any tender that does not confirm to these requirements may be rejected.

07. The successful tender will be required immediately on being declared the purchaser of the rent, to sign the Rent Sale Conditions and to pay the Divisional Secretary, Balangoda, as security deposit such sum as may be fixed by the Divisional Secretary.
