POST OF ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (DEPARTMENTAL) (OPEN/LIMITED COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION)

APPLICATIONS are hereby invited from applicants who possess the qualifications stipulated in this notification for the post of Assistant Director (Departmental) of the Department of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources which is under the purview of the Ministry of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources. Applications prepared in terms of the specimen application form appended at the end of this notification should be sent by registered post to reach the "Commissioner General of Examinations", Organization & Foreign Examination Branch, Department of Examinations, Pelawatta, Battaramulla on or before 03.02.2006.

02. The top left hand corner of the envelope containing the application should be marked "Application for the post of Assistant Director". Applications of those who do not have the stipulated qualifications and, incomplete applications and late applications will be rejected without any notice. Applications will not be acknowledged. No complaint regarding loss of application or any document related thereto in the post will be entertained. Therefore applicants are advised to post their applications well ahead of time in order to avoid delays in the post.

2.1 Applications should be prepared in terms of the specimen application form appended at the end of this notification on paper size 21cm x 29.6cm. It should be noted that the application forms should be so prepared that cages 1 to 7 appear on the first Page, 8 to 12 appear on the second page and the balance appear on the third page inclusive of three pages.

2.2 Applicants who are presently in the Government Service/Provincial Government Service should send their applications through their respective Heads of Department/Institution to reach the address given in Para 1 before the closing date. No application should be sent to the private name of the "Director General" of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources or of any other officer of the Department.

03. Age Limit .— Should be not less than 21 years and not more than 45 years of age as at closing date of applications. (The maximum age limit will not apply to those who are already in government Service)

04. Educational Qualifications .—

For external candidates

- (a) External applicants are eligible to appear only for the open examination and they should possess the following qualifications :

A degree of a recognized university with one of the following subjects.

Zoology, Biology, Marine Biology, Fisheries Biology

- (b) Officers who have the following qualifications and are presently serving in the Department of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources are eligible to sit for the limited examination.

For internal candidates

01. Degree of a recognized university. Officer who holding a satisfactory service of not less than 05 years in a staff post in the fisheries sector.

or

02. Officer who is a member/an associate member of a recognized mechanical, naval or other relevant professional technical institution with satisfactory service of not less than 05 years in a staff post in the Fisheries & Craft evaluation field.

or

03. Officer who has completed not less than 03 years of satisfactory service in a staff post as at the closing date of applications and has not less than 12 years service in the field of fishing craft technology under the Department of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources.

04. Apart from the above categories of officers, the following officers are also eligible to sit for the limited competitive examination.

- (a) Program Managers who have been confirmed in their posts, with not less than 05 years of service.
(b) Program Assistants who have been confirmed in their posts with not less than 08 years of satisfactory service.
(c) Fisheries Inspectors - Grade I with a satisfactory service of 05 years.
(d) Fisheries Inspectors - Grade II and Fisheries Social Development Assistants who have completed a satisfactory service of 12 years.

Note : Applicants who wish to sit for the limited competitive examination should have completed all the efficiency bar examinations relevant to their posts before the closing date of applications.

05. Salary Group & Scale.— As per Public Administration Circular No. 9/2004 Salary Group TB-3-10-1, the annual salary scale for this post is Rs. 1,54,140-15x3,780-2,10,840

06. Efficiency Bars .—

1. Should pass the first efficiency bar within the three years and the second efficiency bar within six years from the date of appointment.
2. This first efficiency bar examination will be held by the Department of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (through the Department of Examinations of Sri Lanka or the Sri Lanka Institute of Development Administration) and it consists of the subjects such as Establishments Code and Financial Regulations. This examination is similar to the first efficiency bar examination for the officers in Class II of the Sri Lanka Administrative Service.
3. The second efficiency bar examination will be held by the Department of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources.
4. No exemption from the efficiency bar examination will be allowed on the basis of age.
5. Efficiency bar examinations will be held only once a year (June 30th will be considered as the date of Examination)

07. Scheme of examination for recruitment

- (a) Both the open and the limited competitive examinations will be held in Sinhala, Tamil and English.
- (b) Candidates who are already serving in the departments should answer this examination in the language in which they passed the qualifying examination/interview for entering the public service or they may answer this examination in an official language.
- (c) A candidate who applied for the open examination should answer all question papers in the language which he opted and will not be permitted to change the medium of language indicated in the application.
- (d) The written test consists of the following subjects
 - (i) Intelligence Test - 100 marks - 01 hour
 - (ii) Comprehension - 100 marks - 1 1/2 hours
(This is to test the candidates' language skill and logical capacity)
 - (iii) General knowledge - 100 marks - 01 hour
This question Paper is designed to test the candidates Knowledge of the political, social, cultural and economic environment of Sri Lanka, international affairs and matters related to the fishing industry)
- (e) Candidates who apply for the open competitive examination should answer all three question papers indicated in (d). Candidates who apply for the limited competitive examination should answer only the two papers of Intelligence and General Knowledge as indicated in (d). Candidates who apply for both open and limited competitive examinations should answer all three papers. The examination will be held by the Commissioner of Examinations only in Colombo in April, 2006.
- (f) Candidates who obtain a minimum of 40% for each paper at the written test of the Open Competitive Examination will be called for an interview. This interview is held only to check the candidate's physical

fitness and his qualifications and certificates. However a number of candidates equal to the number of vacancies to be filled will be called for this interview.

- (g) The candidates who obtain a minimum of 40% for each subject of the limited competitive examination will be called for a structured interview at which marks will be awarded for the period of service, efficiency and other qualifications achieved and the method of awarding marks will be determined by the Public Service Commission. The number of candidates called for the structured interview will not exceed five times the number of the vacancies.
- (h) The existing vacancies in the post will be filled at the ratio of 50% from external candidates and 50% from internal candidates.

08. Conditions of Service .—

- (a) This post is permanent and the holders are entitled to a contributory pension under the contributory pensions fund.

Exception

If a person who has served in a pensionable post before 01.01.2003 is recruited to this post such person will be entitled to a pension under minute on pensions and should contribute to the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Fund.

- (a) The appointees should be physically fit to serve in any part of Sri Lanka.
- (b) Sections 10 to 12 in Chapter II of the Establishments Code will apply.
- (c) All candidates should be Sri Lankan citizens. "Sri Lankan" means by a person who has acquired Sri Lankans citizenship by descent or by registration.

09. The right not to fill the vacancy and the right to exercise discretionary power on any matter not referred to in this notice, will remain with the appointing authority.

- 10 (i) Candidates who are already in public service/public corporations service or provincial public service should answer all question papers of this examination in the language medium in which they passed the qualifying examination for entering the relevant service. However, if they have passed the qualifying examination in a language medium other than Sinhala, they may answer this examination in the Sinhala language at their discretion.
- (ii) Other candidates may answer in this examination in the language medium in which they passed the qualifying examination. However if they wish, they may answer in Sinhala medium.
- (iii) Candidates will not be permitted to change the language medium after the date on which applications closed.

11. Examination Fees .—

(i) The fee is Rs. 300 . It should be paid before the closing date of applications at any District Secretariat/Divisional Secretary's Office or the General Treasury to be credited to Revenue 6000/0/0/3/67. The receipt obtained from the District Secretariat/Divisional Secretary's Office or the Treasury should be pasted to the relevant cage in the application form. The examination fee will not be refunded under any circumstances. (It would be useful to keep a photocopy of the receipt by the applicant).

(ii) The examination will be conducted only in Colombo. The date and centre of examination will be notified in due course to the eligible candidates by the Commissioner General of Examinations, to their personal address given in the application.

(iii) Candidates who fail to produce the admission cards issued by the Commissioner General of Examinations will not be permitted to enter the examination hall for the purpose of sitting for the examination.

(iv) Applications will not be acknowledged. Immediately after the issue of admission cards to the candidates, a press notice will be published. Candidates are advised to be on the lookout for such a notice. A candidate who does not receive his/her admission card at least seven days before the date of examination should make inquiries from the "Commissioner General of Examinations", Organization & Foreign Examination Branch, Department of Examinations, Pelawatta, Battaramulla with a copy of the application.

12. Identity of candidates .— A candidate will be required to prove his/her identity at the examination hall to the satisfaction of the Head of the Examinations Hall when appearing for each subject. For this purpose any of the following documents will be accepted.

(a) National Identity card issued by the Department of Registration of Persons.

(b) A Passport with the candidate's photograph issued not earlier than 05 years prior to the date of examination.

*Any other document or photograph will not be accepted for this purpose.

13. Penalty for furnishing false information

If a candidate is found to be ineligible his/her candidature is liable

to be cancelled at any stage prior to, during or after the examination. If any of the particulars furnished by a candidate are found to be false within his/her knowledge or if he/she has will fully suppressed any material fact he/she will be liable to be dismissed from the public service.

APPLICATIONS are invited from eligible candidates for admission to the National Diploma in Technology, 3 year fulltime Course conducted by the Institute of Technology, University of Moratuwa. The Course will be conducted within the University premises at Moratuwa until it is moved to a new premises of the Institute of Technology, University of Moratuwa.

1. General :

The national Diploma in Technology Course consists of two years of academic study and one year of Industrial Training and it is conducted in the English medium. The course is offered in the following fields of study :

- (i) Chemical Engineering Technology
- (ii) Civil Engineering Technology
- (iii) Electrical Engineering Technology
- (iv) Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering Technology
- (v) Marine Engineering Technology
- (vi) Mechanical engineering Technology
- (vii) Nautical Studies and Technology
- (viii) Polymer Technology
- (ix) Textile and Clothing Technology

2. Eligibility :

2.1 Age :

- (a) Applicants should be below 24 years of age on the closing date of the applications.
- (b) Applicants below 20 years of age on the closing date of the applications, will be given preference for admission to the Nautical Studies and technology Course.
- (c) Those who are fulltime registered students of any University under the UGC (except the Open University of Sri Lanka) or Higher Educational Institute under the Ministry of Education are not eligible to apply.

2.2 Educational Qualifications :

Applicants should have obtained passes in three (03) of the following subjects :

- (i) Physics
 - (ii) Chemistry
 - (iii) Combined Mathematics
 - (iv) Advanced Mathematics
- at one and the same sitting of a G. C. E. (A.L) Examination conducted by the Commissioner General of Examinations, Sri Lanka in 2003 or 2004 or 2005.

3. Selection Criteria :

3.1 Admission to the Course :

The selection of students for admission will be based on the performance at G. C. E. (A.L.) Examination and the aptitude test to be conducted by the Institute of Technology, University of Moratuwa.

From those who pass the aptitude test, selections will be done in the merit order of G. C. E. (A.L.) results, i.e. in the order of z-scores. In the selection, 40% merit and 60% district quota will be applied.

3.2 Field of Study :

Aptitude test marks together with the applicant's order of preference for the field of study as indicated in the field preference will be considered in the allocation of the field of study.

4. Application Procedure :

4.1 Application form :
