Post of Deputy Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation

APPLICATIONS are invited for the post of Deputy Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation.

02. Eligibility -

- (i) A President, Labour Tribunal who is an Attorney - at - Law and whose period of service as such President Labour Tribunal is not less than two years ; or
- (ii) An Attorney at - Law who has been in active practice for not less than three years ; or
- (iii) An Attorney - at - Law who has served in a legal capacity in any Ministry or Government Department or a State Corporation for not less than four years ; or
- (iv) An Attorney-at - Law who has served in a legal capacity in any Legal Firm, Bank or any recognized Mercantile Establishment for not less than four years and who has regularly appeared before court during such period.

Knowledge of laws relating to Workmen Compensation and experience in relation to such laws would be considered an added qualification.

03. *Salary Scale.* - Rs. 238,920-7 x 8,580 - 298,980 (T. B. 12.8).

04. Applications on forms obtainable from this office may be made by persons having the necessary qualifications to reach me on or before 15th February, 2006.

Note.-1. Requests for application forms by post should be accompanied by self addressed stamped envelopes not smaller than 9x4 in size.

2. To ensure that applications are duly received in this office, applicants are advised to hand over the applications personally or to send them by registered post.

05. Every applicant must be -

- (a) of excellent moral character and physically fit ; and
- (b) a citizen of Sri Lanka.

06. Applicants will be required to produce any or all of the following documents when called upon to do so :

- (a) Certificate of birth,
- (b) Highest educational certificate,
- (c) Certificates of professional qualifications, and
- (d) Certificate of the highest examination passed in Sinhala/Tamil.

07. Applications from officers in the Public Service must be forwarded through the Heads of Departments.

08. Applications and any other Communications relating thereto must be addressed to the Secretary Judicial Service Commission and not to any other officer in this office.

09. Applications will be acknowledged. If any applicant does not receive an acknowledgment within two weeks, he should notify the Secretary, Judicial Service Commission.
